




LASERs come in four major classes based on power: 1, 2, 3, 4

Classes are also represented by Roman numerals: I, II, III, IV

LASER pointers are available as either: Class 2 or Class 3a/3R

Handheld LASER devices are higher powered Class 3b & Class 4




LOOKS CAN BE DECEIVING



<u>Important things to remember</u>

- Class 3b & 4 LASERs have the potential to cause eye damage before your blink response
- Only 3a (5mW max. power) and lower LASER pointers should be used for presentations
- ← Green and blue LASERs tend to be more powerful
- <u>– DON'T STARE AT THE BEAM!! Never point a LASER at anyone's eyes!</u>
