JP Morgan Chase Fraud Prevention

If you have a Dartmouth Purchasing Card (PCard) or Corporate Card, be on the lookout for emails from "JPMorganChase FraudPrevention". These are NOT spam and should not be ignored. Cardholder alerts notify you of suspicious activity on your account and allow you to quickly reply to validate transactions. To verify the email is legitimately from JP Morgan Chase, check the email address. The email address will be from:

jpmorganchase.fraudprevention@jpmchase.com

If you have questions or concerns about the authenticity of a message, call JP Morgan Chase anytime at 1-800-316-6056 or the number on the back of your card. To enroll in cardholder fraud alerts, a simple way to strengthen your defenses and keep fraudsters at bay, sign up at: ccportal.jpmorgan.com. You will have two options to receive notifications through mobile SMS text messages and/or an email when there is suspected fraud on your account.

Employee & Student Gift Policy Reminder

'Tis the season for giving and appreciation, making it an opportune time to remind everyone of the <u>Business Expense</u> <u>policy on Gifts to Employees and Students</u>.

Allowable Gifts (charged to a GL string only):

- Gifts or gift cards (under \$50 per person) in recognition of a work-related accomplishment or event.
- An item in recognition of the death or serious illness of an employee or immediate family member (up to \$100). (Flowers are not taxable but any other item \$50 and over would be)
- Institutional or divisional service awards

Gifts for long-service or retiring employee (Dartmouth recommends \$15 per year of service with a max of \$400 for retirement gifts).

Financial Account Review Reminder

As we approach the end of the second quarter, we would like to underscore the importance and necessity of regular and timely review of financial transactions for those responsible for overseeing financial accounts. The Financial Account Review Guidelines site provides guidance on the systematic review of transactions charged to Dartmouth GL and sponsored accounts. This site outlines the significance of regular financial reviews, defines roles and responsibilities, and suggests the optimal approach for scrutinizing financial transactions. Additionally, the guidance outlines the retention and system of record for financial records. If you have not yet conducted a year-to-date review of your financial accounts, now is the time.

Reminder for On-Campus Purchases

When making on-campus purchases, such as from the Dartmouth computer store, Hanover Inn, DDS, Athletics, or Central Stores, for Dartmouth business, please ensure to provide your chart string instead of using a corporate or procurement card or personal funds with reimbursement. This approach is more efficient for you and all parties involved in the transaction, helping to avoid unnecessary fees and additional labor during subsequent processing.
