EXECUTIVE SUMMARY PREPARED FOR THE DARTMOUTH COMMUNITY FISCAL 2021

Summary

In fiscal 2021 the Advisory Committee on Investor Responsibility (ACIR) was unable to function in its usual form and all proxy voting was done based on ACIR's previous recommendations and voting history. In fiscal 2021 there were only 11 votes recommended, which is a significant decrease from past years. As the portfolio shifts away from direct share ownership, the number of proxy votes continues to decline.

ACIR Recommendations on the Voting of Proxy Resolutions

As of January 31, 2021, there were 105 directly held publicly traded equities, 4 of which Dartmouth submitted proxy votes related to environmental, social, or governance issues.
