

## Cataloging Juvenile Literature

These guidelines apply only to materials meeting one of the following criteria:

- New materials classing in PZ (unless there's a note asking us NOT to class in PZ)
- New English language materials with a "Juvenile literature" subdivision in a subject heading

Records should contain the following information:

- 008 field (RLIN = INT; OCLC = Audn) should contain one of the following codes:  
a ; b ; c ; d ; j

If your record does not contain one of these values, you can look it up in the MARC manuals (OCLC bibliographic formats and standards), or you can ask.

- 586 bb Awards Note

If there is a note asking us to add a note for Caldecott Medal or other medal, please add a 586 field, if not already present. Add the date of the award, if easily available. For example:

586 bb Newbery Medal.

586 bb Caldecott Medal, 2000.

- Always add a 655 b7 genre heading. You'll have to determine what kind of literature it is in order to figure out which heading to add. If in doubt, please ask.

For fiction:  
655 b0 Children's stories.

For drama:  
655 b0 Children's plays.

For poetry:  
655 b0 Children's poetry.

For non-fiction and general collections:  
655 b0 Children's literature.
