Minutes for meeting on Tuesday, October 18, 2011 Treasure Room, Baker Library

- 1. Welcome and introductions
- 2. Open Access: Barbara DeFelice and Elizabeth Kirk presented a powerpoint slideshow that touched upon several different aspects of open access (OA) publishing. Differences between OA alternatives were highlighted, including the types of OA options utilized by the Dartmouth faculty in different disciplines. Library services that are available to the Dartmouth community to support OA and author retention of copyright were also reviewed. COL members asked a number of questions about the timeline and procedures for copyright retention as well as the OA policies at other universities.
- 3. Berlin Declaration: Jeffrey Horrell, Barbara DeFelice and Elizabeth Kirk provided background on the "Berlin Declaration on Open Access to Knowledge in the Sciences and Humanities" and a discussion followed as to whether Dartmouth should add its signature to this growing movement. The COL voted yes, but with a clarifying statement regarding how OA publications should be used in tenure and promotion decisions. - 4. COL members were encouraged to think about and suggest topics for upcoming meetings.
