<b>Similar Patients</b>	
1. Are your patients similar to those in the study?	
2. Are they so different that the results can't help you?	
3. How much of the study effect can you expect for your patients?	
<b>Realistic Interventions</b>	
4. Is the intervention realistic in your setting?	
5. Does the comparison intervention reflect your current practice?	
6. What alternatives are available?	
<b>Right Outcomes</b>	
7. Have all the right outcomes been considered?	
8. Are the outcomes appropriate to your patient?	
9. Does the intervention meet their values and preferences?
