
The CPHS serves as the institutional review boards (IRBs) for Dartmouth College and the institutions comprising the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center. The CPHS includes each of the IRBs established by The Trustees of Dartmouth College. It is registered with both the Office for Human Research Protection (OHRP) in the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and with the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA).
