Hip fracture is the most morbid of all fractures, with 15% to 20% of patients dying during the subsequent year. The startling results of several clinical trails related to estrogen/progestin use have changed the global view of how clinicians can work with patients to ensure healthy bones over the long term. No longer is one type of intervention seen as being "the answer" for the long term. Dr. Cosman urges clinicians to view the patient in terms of her--or his--whole life cycle and to intervene according to the most suitable therapy for the individual and his or her age group. In this telecourse, Dr. Cosman discusses a rational approach to estrogen/progestin use and the emerging role of newer drugs that can build bone mass over time.
