DEN, as it is known, is the outgrowth of an Environmental Issues Symposium that was held as part of the Moosilauke Ravine Lodge 50th Anniversary celebration in 1989. The College granted official recognition to DEN on Earth Day in 1990. Today DEN enjoys the distinction of being the only Friends Group that provides support to an academic department of the College.
