## Reserve Readings for Classes

## BorrowDirect & DartDoc

There may be times when the material you need isn't available in the Dartmouth Library. When this happens you can turn to these services:

**Borrow Direct** allows you to request books directly from a select few prestigious universities around the Northeast. Books arrive faster than through DartDoc, usually 4 business days. Ideal if a book is not owned by Dartmouth, or is lost or checked out. A loan period of 30 days is given, and books cannot be renewed. ### Bankruptcy Insider

Bankruptcy Insider – search across proprietary bankruptcy data. Includes news on who is providing financing, details about rehabilitations and liquidations around the world, bankruptcy trends and much more. Drill down into data on DIPs, filings, advisers, investment banks and M&A bankruptcy. You can

customize searches based on industry, time period and geographic location.

Datastream Advance provides historical data and analytics from both developed and emerging markets: equities, market indices, company accounts, macroeconomics, bonds, foreign exchange, interest rates, commodities and derivatives. Data is available in daily, weekly, monthly, quarterly, and yearly formats, and is available for as much as 30 years and in some cases even more. Data can be easily transferred into Excel spreadsheets.

## Directory of Alternative Investment Programs

Location: workstation #4, 8, & 9 1<sup>st</sup> floor of Feldberg

The Directory of Alternative Investment Programs provides detailed profiles of the private equity investment programs of pension funds, foundations, endowments, corporations, and more. AIP allows one to screen sources by location, industry, amount of capital, type of sources, etc.

## **Disclosure (microfiche)**

Location: 1<sup>st</sup> floor of Feldberg

SEC filings (10-K, 10-Q, Proxy statement, Prospectus, and annual reports) for companies listed on the American Stock Exchange, the New York Stock Exchange, and "over the counter" exchanges. Filings dated from 1970 to 1989 (see Mergent Online for filings dated from 1998 to date; see GAPro for filings 1989 to mid 1998).

## **Dismal Scientist**

Dismal Scientist provides real-time monitoring and detailed economic analysis, economic indicators, and forecasts for the United States and Canada.

## **Dun & Bradstreet's Million Dollar Database**

D&B's Million Dollar Database – search for information on over 14 million U.S. leading public and private businesses, regardless of their size. You can search for companies by company name, ticker, industry, size or geography. You can also search for information on executives.

## **EconLit**

Coverage: 1969 to date

EconLit – search for economic articles from academic journals, books and dissertations covering management and business; country studies; economic development, financial economics; industrial organization; labor and demographic economics; macroeconomics and more.

## **EIU Country Reports & Profiles**

The Economist Intelligence Unit's Country Reports & Profiles provides in-depth analysis of the current political, policy and economic trends for more than 200 countries. Includes 5 years of macroeconomic data.

## **EIU CountryData**

Coverage: 1980 to date and forecasting out 5 years

EIU CountryData is a database of economic indicators for 150 countries and 45 regional aggregates. It has annual, quarterly, monthly and forecast time series data on over 300 variables on economic structure, foreign payments, external debt stock, external debt service, external trade, and more.

## **ePharmaceuticals**

ePharmaceuticals provides current business information on the pharmaceutical industry, including news, market research reports and white papers.

## **Factiva**

Factiva – search for articles from over 10,000 publications worldwide, including: newswires, newspapers, magazines and trade journals focusing on business, including the Wall Street Journal, Barron's, the Boston Globe, and the New York Times. Factiva also provides financial profiles for companies worldwide and historical stock prices as well as currency data and market indexes.

## **Galante's Venture Capital & Private Equity Directory**

Location: workstation #4, 8, & 9 1<sup>st</sup> floor of Feldberg

Galante's is a guide to every type of risk capital for private, entrepreneurial companies including: over 2,000 venture capital, LBO/MBO, and mezzanine firms. You can search by name, location, investment size, transaction size, type of capital, funding stage preference, and geographic and industry preferences.

## **GAPro (Global Access Pro)**

Coverage: 1989 to mid-1998

Location: workstation #12 1<sup>st</sup> floor of Feldberg

GAPro provides access to 10K's, Annual Reports, Prospectuses, and Proxy Statements of the 12,000+ companies filing with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). Annual Reports for over 7,000 International Companies are also available. SEC documents prior to 1989 are available in our microfiche collection and mid-1998 to date on Mergent Online.

## Global Business Browser (OneSource)

Global Business Browser (GBB) provides a wide range of information on almost 14 million public, private, and nonprofit companies worldwide. GBB also includes information on industries and executives. Find news, detailed financial data, market research reports, analyst reports, executive biographies, SWOT analysis, significant developments, strategic initiatives, industry norms, market share, and more. Company Finder can be used to screen the database of companies creating lists of companies that match a given set of criteria (a great tool for job hunting).

## Global Financial Data

Coverage: back to 1264 for some series

Global Financial Data – find historical stock market, financial, and economic time series data covering 200 countries and 20,000 different data series.

Includes data on stock markets from 1690, exchange rates from 1590, interest rates from 1700, commodities from 1500, and inflation from 1264. Selected current and historical stock price data is also available.

## Global Market Information Database

Global Market Information Database (GMID), produced by Euromonitor, provides access to over a million demographic, economic and marketing statistics for 205 countries worldwide and 6-year historic market size data for more than 330 consumer products in 52 countries, plus 5-year forecasts. You'll find country profiles and statistics, lifestyle indicators and analysis, market data and analysis and profiles of companies and marketshare.

## Hoover's Pro Online

Hoover's Pro Online is a database of company & industry information covering 40,000 public, private, US, and non-US companies and more than 600 industries. Hoover's includes the following: company overview, history, news, officers & employees, location & subsidiaries, products & operations, competitors & industry, financials and research reports.

## I/B/E/S Rewind

Location: Workstation #12 1<sup>st</sup> floor of Feldberg

I/B/E/S Rewind provides historical earnings forecast data on over 16,000 companies in 47 countries. The software allows you to conveniently graph and display historical data on either a single company or multiple

companies. There are 2 CD-ROMs, one for U.S. companies and one for International companies. This database is also available via WRDS.

## International Financial Statistics

International Financial Statistics, published by the International Monetary Fund (IMF), is a standard source for statistics on all aspects of international and domestic finance. IFS contains approximately 32,000 time series covering more than 200 countries. Data includes: exchange rates, Fund position, liquidity, money and banking accounts, interest rates, prices, production, international transactions, government accounts, national accounts and population for countries around the world.

## Investext Plus

Coverage 1996 to date

Investext provides access to investment, company, and industry analyst reports from more than 500 investment banks and 190 trade associations in North America, Europe, Asia/Pacific, Latin America, Africa, and the Middle East.

## ISI Emerging Markets

ISI Emerging Markets provides information about emerging market countries, their companies, and industries. It includes country profiles; macroeconomic statistics, forecasts, and analysis; reports on financial markets, companies and industries; exchange rates; analyst reports; and business news, both in English and the local languages. Coverage includes countries from Latin America, Central & Eastern Europe, Central Asia-Caucasus, Southeast Europe, Asia, Australia, Africa, and Middle East.

## LexisNexis Academic UNIVERse

LexisNexis Academic UNIVERse – search for articles from news, business, legal, and medical publications and information sources. International resources in French, Italian, and German are also included, as well as, legal information consisting of federal and state case law, statutes, secondary sources such as law reviews, and state legal materials.

Lexis Nexis Research – search for articles from wire services, newspapers, trade journals, and magazines; the full-text of patents from 1971 to date; legal, legislative, and regulatory information including federal and state case law, statutes, and law review articles; company directories; SEC filings and more. Lexis Nexis Academic provides access to a subset of the information available here but has a more user friendly web interface. If you are interested in using the research interface please see a reference librarian.

## MarketLine Business Information Centre

MarketLine's Business Information Centre provides information on companies, industries and countries. Find industry profiles, company profiles, company SWOT analyses, country profiles, news and commentary.

## McKinsey Quarterly Online

*McKinsey Quarterly* is the business journal of the global management-consulting firm McKinsey & Company. Articles, written by McKinsey consultants, offer new ways of thinking about management in the private, public, and nonprofit sectors.

## Mediamark Reporter

Mediamark Reporter offers comprehensive demographic, lifestyle, product usage, and media data collected from a single sample. These data provide strategic insights, consumer targeting, brand trial/loyalty, promotional opportunities, and trade marketing. Mediamark surveys annually more than 25,000 consumers throughout the continental United States and provides data on a syndicated basis. The survey methodology uses a personal interview and a self-administered questionnaire. 1986 - 1998 is in hardcopy on the 2nd floor, circulating collection: HF 5410.M44.

## Mergent Online

Mergent Online is a database of company and industry information as well as and country profiles. Use Mergent to access SEC filings. We have access to the following:

- U.S. Company Data: 15,000 NYSE, AMEX and NASDAQ companies, as well as real-time access to EDGAR® filings, dating back to 1993. Coverage includes: history, business, property, subsidiaries, officers, directors, long-term debt, bond ratings, capital stock, income statement, balance sheet, statements of cash flow, exchange and ticker symbol, address, telephone number, annual stock price ranges, trustees, registrar, transfer agent, stock splits, dividend payment history and more.
- U.S. Company Archives Data: full business descriptions, history and financial statements for more than 4,000 companies that were acquired, went bankrupt, liquidated or merged out of existence from 1995 onward.

- International Company Data: 20,000 non-U.S. based corporations, companies representing 95% of the non-U.S. global market capitalization.
- International Company Archives Data: 2,000 non-U.S. companies that have merged, were acquired, went bankrupt, liquidated or otherwise disappeared from 1995 forward.
- Country Profiles: provides profiles for countries around the world including: history, geography, people, government, economy, communications, transportation, military, transnational issues, and stock exchange information.

### **Morningstar's Principia Pro for Closed-End Funds**

Coverage: 2002 to date

Location: workstation #7 1<sup>st</sup> floor of Feldberg

The Closed-End Funds database includes comprehensive information on nearly 500 closed-end funds. There are over 130 data items that can be screened and reported on to help with your analysis of the funds. Updated quarterly.

### **Multi Media Class/Brand \$**

Location: workstation #11 1<sup>st</sup> floor of Feldberg

Class/Brand \$ provides quarterly and year-to-date advertising expenditures per medium and the 10-media total for each company and brand, by industry classification. Media include magazines, newspapers, television, radio and outdoor.

### **New York Times (ProQuest)**

Coverage: 1851 to 2003

Coverage: 1980 to date

The New York Times database gives you access to articles, in PDF format, from 1851 to date.

### **Newspaper Direct**

Newspaper Direct, also known as Library PressDisplay, is a database that includes 250 newspapers from 55 countries in their original format, layout and pagination. Texts are searchable, and about 30 papers (LA Times, Washington Post, etc.) have enhanced features ("SmartNavigation") for easy reading or cutting and pasting. The file for each newspaper goes back 60 days.

### **Pink Sheet: Prescription Pharmaceuticals And Biotechnology**

The Pink Sheet - known as 'The Bible' to the prescription pharmaceutical industry, this specialized weekly publication covers regulatory activities of FDA, FTC and CMS; Congress; industry news, such as mergers and acquisitions, new product introductions and executive changes; and financial news, such as companies sales and earning performance and stock activity. The publication covers research, manufacturing, distribution and the retail sector.
