Institutional Charges: I, the student, (and we, the parents, in the case of a Direct PLUS Loan) authorize Dartmouth College to apply Federal Title IV financial aid funds to allowable institutional charges such as tuition, room, board and required fees and also to other educationally related expenses which might be posted to my student account.
