



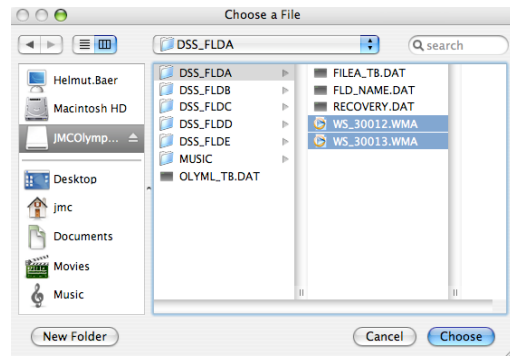
# AudialHub: Converting .wma Files to .mp3 /.aiff /.wav



If you are using a JMC Olympus Digital Recorder: Make sure to **turn off** the device before connecting to the USB port of the computer.



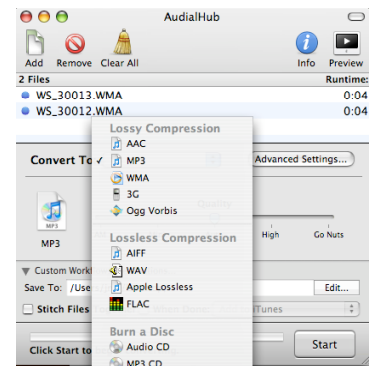
1. Open the **Audial Hub** application from the dock.
2. From the AudialHub **File** menu, select **Add File...**  
Browse for the .wma file(s) in the appropriate folder of the Olympus recorder (Folder A is displayed as "DSS\_FLDA") and click **Choose**.



*Note: The JMC Olympus Audio Recorder appears as an icon on the desktop.*



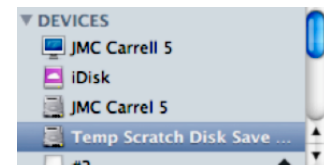
3. **File Format**  
In AudialHub, select a file format from the **Convert To** drop down menu.  
*Note: For lossy compression settings (e.g. .mp3), you can adjust the **Quality** setting slider - higher quality means higher bitrate and larger file size.*



## 4. Location

**Important!** By default, AudialHub **saves converted files to the same location as the original files: the Olympus Audio File Folder!**

To change the save location, click **Edit** (under **Save To**) and select new location. Save your audio files to an **external drive** or to the **Temp Scratch Disk - Save Files Here** partition of the JMC Computer.



5. Click the **Start** button to convert and save the file using the settings you selected.
