

iSkysoft iMedia Converter

Export Still Frames From Video




You can export still frames as JPEG files from a DVD, video file, or iMovie project using iSkysoft iMedia Converter. The software is available at the Jones Media Center Editing Stations.

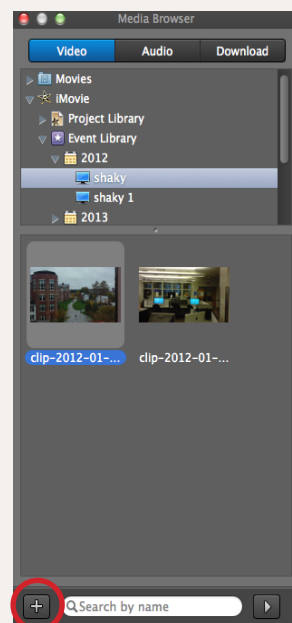
1. Open iSkysoft iMedia Converter by clicking the icon in the dock.





2. To import media, drag and drop the video file to the iSkysoft iMedia Converter window.

If you are importing from a DVD, insert the DVD in the computer drive. In the pop-up window **Do you want to load the following DVD**, click **OK**. You have a choice to either load **Main Movie Only** or **All Title**. You can also import video by selecting **Load Media Files** or **Load DVD Files** from the file menu.


3. To import video directly from iMovie, click the **Show Media Browser** button  in the top right corner and select the **Video** tab.



4. Navigate to the iMovie Event Library and select a specific event and video file. Click the  button to load the file.

5. In the iSkysoft main window, click the pencil button  for the clip that contains the image you want to export. The **Edit** window will pop up.

6. Navigate to the frame you want to capture using the scrubber bar at the bottom of the window. To capture the exact frame, use the LEFT and RIGHT arrow keys on the keyboard.

7. Click the arrow on the **Snapshot** button  and from the pull down menu select **Set Snapshot Folder**. Choose the location where you want your still frames to be saved to, e.g. the desktop. Click the camera icon on the **Snapshot** button to take a picture of the selected frame.
