


## Burning Video to a DVD


Once you have exported your iMovie or Final Cut project as a video file, you can use iSkysoft to burn your movie to a DVD disc. This will create a DVD that allows you to play your movie on a computer or standard DVD player.

## Steps to burn a video file to a DVD:

- 1. In iSkysoft, select the **Burn** option from the menu on the top of the window –
- 2. Import your video file into iSkysoft using either of the following methods:



Or




Click and drag your video file into the drop area



- 3. Leave **Burn Video To** set to the computer's DVD drive (external DVD drives are available for checkout at the front desk)

  Burn Video to: PIONEER BD-R...
- 4. Select a Template for your DVD menu or choose No Menu
- 5. Enter a name for your DVD in the DVD Label field
- 6. Select your appropriate Aspect Ratio: **4:3** for Standard or **16:9** for Widescreen
- 7. Insert a blank DVD into the computer's DVD drive (blank DVDs are available for purchase at the front desk)
- 8. Select your desired quality (the colored status bar indicates the amount of space you have on your disc. If it is red, your movie file is too large and will need to be reformatted)
- 9. If you are burning a Dual-Layer DVD, select DVD 9 (8.5GB). Otherwise, leave it set to DVD 5(4.5GB)
- 10. To preview your DVD's menu & video, click the play button. If you are satisfied with the preview, click **Burn**.
