Head Coach Bob Gaudet



Bob Gaudet enters his seventh season as head coach of the Big Green. Gaudet is a 1981 graduate of Dartmouth and played four years for the varsity hockey team as a goaltender. He came back to

Dartmouth after nine successful seasons behind the Brown University bench.

At Dartmouth, Gaudet has guided the Big Green to three straight winning seasons, including 20 wins last year for the first time since 1947-48. It marks the first time since 1971-1974 that Dartmouth has had three consecutive winning seasons. He also led the Big Green to home playoff series the last three years and in 2001, the program made its first trip to the ECAC semifinals in 20 years.

Gaudet's career coaching record stands at a respectable **187-237-61**.

Gaudet graduated in 1981 with a degree in visual arts after four productive seasons for the Big Green hockey team. In 1979 and 1980, Gaudet led the Big Green to Ivy League titles and appearances in the NCAA Final Four. As a senior, he served as co-captain and was a recipient of the Philip D. McInnis Award for spirit, loyalty and dedication to Dartmouth ice hockey. In 76 career games, he made a school-record 2,129 saves while allowing only 299 goals for a 4.00 career goals against average and an .877 save percentage. He was first team All-Ivy in 1978-79 and 1979-80, and was a two-time recipient of the Canterbury Society Award for the best Ivy League goalie.

Following graduation, Gaudet signed a free-agent contract with the Winnipeg Jets of the National Hockey League. He played for minor league affiliates of Winnipeg in the CHL and IHL.

Gaudet and his wife Lynne – also a 1981 Dartmouth graduate – reside in Hanover with their three children: sons Joey and Jimmy plus daughter Kelly.

GETTING TO ALBANY

ECAC QUARTERFINALS vs. RENSSELAER

Dartmouth advanced to the semifinals after a 1-0 victory over Rensselaer on Sunday, March 14. The Big Green dropped a 3-1 decision on Friday, March 12 and then evened the series with a 6-0 win the following night.

In Game One, Rensselaer jumped out to a quick two-goal lead before Mike Ouellette put the Big Green within striking distance only four minutes into the third period. But Dartmouth netminder Dan Yacey was pulled in favor of the extra skater allowing the Engineers to capture the 3-1 win with an empty netter.

The Big Green bounced back with a vengeance in the second game as a half-dozen players scored in a 6-0 blanking.

The shutout was Dartmouth's second of the season and the first playoff shutout since 1980 when the Big Green downed Rensselaer, 8-0. The goalie that night was current head coach Bob Gaudet '81 who made 23 saves.

In the decisive game, the teams skated through two scoreless stanzas before Eric Przepiorka capitalized for the Big Green. The sophomore forward won the face-off to start the third period and deflected the puck to Sean Offers who then fed Tanner Glass.

Przepiorka beat his defender after Glass set him up with a pass off the boards and fired a backhand wrister from 15 feet for the game's only goal.

Several Big Green skaters proved their mettle as big game players. Lee Stempniak was the leading scorer in the three games, notching one goal and three assists. Ouellette was also was a multiple-point scorer for Dartmouth with two goals and one assist. Przepiorka scored two goals.

The hero of the series might be junior goalie Dan Yacey. Yacey was superb between the posts, recording a total of 91 saves, earning two shutouts and giving up only two goals.

DROP THE PUCK – The 2003-04 season marks the 97th season of Dartmouth men’s hockey. The first puck dropped for the Big Green in 1905-06. Dartmouth did not field a team in 1918-19.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN– Dartmouth senior defenseman Brian Van Abel was chosen as captain to lead the 2003-04 squad. Lee Stempniak is the assistant captain.

DRAFT DODGERS – Sophomore Hugh Jessiman, junior Lee Stempniak and freshman Tanner Glass were all chosen in the 2003 NHL draft. Jessiman was the highest ever draft selection for Dartmouth and the highest for the ECAC since 1983. Jessiman was the 10th overall pick in the first round going to the New York Rangers. Stempniak was picked by St. Louis in the fifth round and Glass went in the seventh round to Florida.

THERE’S NO PLACE LIKE HOME – The Big Green has spent 28 seasons in the friendly confines of Thompson Arena. Since Coach Gaudet took over the reins, the attendance and the winning have gone up. Since 1997 the Big Green has an impressive **52-32-13** record at home. Overall Dartmouth is **.536** on home ice, playing to a record of **175-204-24**. For the 2003-04 season Dartmouth is averaging **4,037** fans per game.

POSTSEASON HONORS: Three Dartmouth men's hockey players garnered postseason All-Ivy and All-ECAC honors. Junior Lee Stempniak and freshman Grant Lewis were selected first team while sophomore Hugh Jessiman was named second team. Lewis was also selected for the ECAC All-Rookie Team.

HONORS HISTORY: With the inclusion of Grant Lewis on the All-ECAC first team it’s the first time a first-year player has been chosen since Christian Soucy, a goalie from Vermont in 1991-92. It’s also the first time a freshman defenseman has been named to the team since Jack Hughes (Harvard, 1976-77). Dartmouth has never had two All-ECAC first team selections in the same year and the Big Green has never had three players combined on the two teams in the same year.

SEASON HONORS – Dartmouth has had five players given weekly ECAC honors. The most recent was Dan Yacey picking up his second Goalie of the Week on March 15. Grant Lewis has also been honored twice, most recently for the week of Feb. 23. Freshman Dan Shribman was chosen Rookie of the Week for Feb. 3. Junior Lee Stempniak received Co-Player of the Week for the week of Jan. 20. Yacey was named Goalie of the Week Nov. 3 while Hugh Jessiman was named Co-Player of the Week and Lewis was chosen Rookie of the Week for Nov. 24. Jessiman and senior captain Brian Van Abel were both chosen for the Sheraton Banknorth Classic All-Tournament team.

WALTER BROWN AWARD – Dartmouth assistant captain Lee Stempniak is one of the 14 finalists for the Walter Brown Award to be announced in April. Dartmouth has never had a Walter Brown Award winner. Former Big Green captain Trevor Byrne was a finalist for the award last year.

ECAC GOALIE OF THE WEEK – Junior goaltender Dan Yacey earned ECAC Goalie of the Week honors twice, first on November 3 and recently on March 15. For his first award he was in goal for a victory and a tie against Brown and Harvard. He allowed only three goals while stopping 51 shots. In the ECAC quarterfinals he posted 91 saves in three games against Rensselaer. He notched a 0.67 goals against average and a .978 save percentage.

GOALIE STATISTICS – Yacey currently has a 2.44 goals against average and a .914 save percentage. In the ECAC for overall games he is ninth in goals against and save percentage. Freshman Sean Samuel got in on the action in his first start against Minnesota State. Samuel has played in six games with 74 saves.

WATCHING YACEY – If the season ended today, Yacey would be in the career goalie records for Dartmouth. Currently he is fifth in career goals against average with 2.45, first with .916 save percentage and tied for ninth in wins with 14.

POSTSEASON POWER-PLAYS: Rensselaer's power-play goal in the second period in Game One was the first power-play strike the Big Green had given up in three games. Dartmouth has allowed only three power-play goals in the last nine games.

MORE POSTSEASON POWER-PLAYS: Against Rensselaer in the quarterfinals, Dartmouth was stellar on special teams allowing, one power-play tally on 13 chances.

MEET YOU IN THE PLAYOFFS: Dartmouth and Harvard will meet in the ECAC Tournament for the second straight year. This will serve as just the third-ever playoff meeting between the two teams, and each of the previous two occurred in the last three seasons. The 2001 teams met in the consolation game (a 3-2 OT win for the Crimson) and Harvard won a 5-3 decision in last year's semis.

30 AND COUNTING: The 2003-04 season marks the third straight season that Dartmouth will play more than 30 games. The Big Green season record is 34 set by the 2002-03 and 2000-01 squads.

THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM: Last year's quarterfinals against Colgate marked the first time that Dartmouth had forced a third game in the ECAC playoffs.

CENTURY CLUB: Jason Costa and Mike Turner have now joined Brian Van Abel (125 games played) as current Dartmouth players with more than 100 games played in their career as Costa is at 102 and Turner is at 100. Lee Stempniak is the only junior with over 90 games played at 98.

JOIN THE CLUB – Against Yale (Feb. 21) Lee Stempniak became the 30th player in Dartmouth's 97-year history to earn 100 points in his career. He became the first player since Ross Brownridge '80 to do the feat during his junior campaign.

THAT'S THE POINT – Hugh Jessiman and Lee Stempniak were Dartmouth's leading scorers last season and they've continued that trend this year. Jessiman and Stempniak finished the regular season as the team leaders in points with 32 apiece. Stempniak is tied for 16th nationally in scoring while Jessiman is tied for fifth in power play goals.

MORE POINT – Lee Stempniak led the team in scoring in 2002-03 with 49 points. It was the most points in a season for a Big Green player since Ross Brownridge had 59 in 1979-80.

HIGH SCORING DUO – Lee Stempniak and Hugh Jessiman combined for 96 points last season and were the first duo to record 40-point seasons since 1978-79. They were also the first pair to record 20-goal seasons since 1975-76. This year they have **69** points (31 goals and 38 assists) between them.

HIGH STREAKING STEMPNIAK – Stempniak has scored in 20 of Dartmouth's 32 games including 11 multiple-point games.

POST-SEASON STEMPNIAK – Lee Stempniak continues to rack up points in the post season. He has scored seven goals and 10 assists in the three years Dartmouth has advanced in the ECAC Tournament.

FEEL THE POWER – Dartmouth enjoys its power play opportunities against several teams. In the four games against Yale and Princeton, the Big Green went 10-18 on the extra man while holding the two opponents to 6-23. In five games against Rensselaer Dartmouth went 8-25. The Big Green has scored 29 power-play goals with Hugh Jessiman leading the team with 10.

LESS POWER – Dartmouth has not scored a power play goal in 12 games this year. The Big Green has not allowed a power-play goal in nine contests. Dartmouth has given up only three power play strikes in its last nine games.

COACH GAUDET TIES IT UP – The Big Green has nine ties this season. Under Bob Gaudet's tutelage Dartmouth has gone **10-12-6** when coming off a tie game. The previous school record for ties was five.

JUST A LITTLE SHORT – Mike Turner's short-handed goal in the first period against Yale was the first for the Big Green this season. Lee Stempniak has added to the short-handed category, grabbing his first of the season in a 2-2 tie with Clarkson on Jan. 16 and Mike Ouellette recorded one on Feb. 14 against Clarkson. Dartmouth allowed two short-handed goals against UMass and Minnesota-State Mankato for the first time since Jan. 24, 2003.

CAREER NIGHT – Hugh Jessiman had four goals and five points on Nov. 21 at Yale, tying his career high for both. Eric Przepiorka assisted on three of Jessiman's goals setting a career high. Against Princeton on Nov. 20, Nathan Szymanski scored twice, a career high, and set another career high with three helpers against Vermont and Princeton. Netminder Dan Yacey has gotten into the career fray with his 44 stops against BU, shattering his previous career high of 36, which he had against Boston College on Nov. 25.

THANKS FOR THE HAT – The Big Green has three hat tricks this year. The first came against Brown (11/7), when Lee Stempniak recorded the third hat trick of his career and the first for Dartmouth since March 13, 2003. Hugh Jessiman had a natural hat trick against Yale (11/21), scoring all three goals in the second period. He finished with four on the night. Mike Ouellette potted his second career hat trick against St. Lawrence (1/17), recording two empty net strikes. He ended the game with four points tying a career-high.

GAME-TIME – Senior Brian Van Abel was out with an injury against New Hampshire on Jan. 13, missing his first game since Nov. 20, 2002. Van Abel has played in **120** games during his four-year career. He is in eighth place on the Dartmouth career charts. Dartmouth will play 29 regular-season games this year with the possibility of post-season. Trevor Byrne graduated last year as the career leader with 130 games played.

SHOOTERS – Dartmouth had 50 shots on goal against Colgate on Feb. 7, the most this season. Ten times Dartmouth has had more than 40 shots in a game.

FRESHMAN ACCOLADES– Grant Lewis was named to the CSTV E-List of top defensemen on Jan. 23. He also earned a ranking of 29th in the NHL Central Scouting Bureau's midterm rankings that were released on Jan. 8. Lewis and Dan Shribman have both been named ECAC Rookies of the Week. Lewis was also given first team All-Ivy and All-ECAC honors.

SPREAD IT AROUND – Dartmouth has been spreading the scoring around. Sixteen players have recorded at least one goal while 21 players have at least one point. Three players have over 10 goals and five have over 10 assists.

STREAKING – Nathan Szymanski had his six-game scoring streak broken against Harvard. Lee Stempniak and Grant Lewis have also both recorded six-game scoring streaks this season. During Stempniak's streak he scored five goals and six assists with three multiple-point games. Lewis' streak consisted of seven assists and one goal and Szymanski potted three goals and six assists in his six games. Hugh Jessiman and Eric Przepiorka have both had four-game streaks.

SCORING G-O-A-L-S – The six second-period goals against Minnesota State-Mankato in UVM's tournament were the most the Big Green has scored in a period this season. The eight goals by Dartmouth in that game tied a tournament high.

G-O-A-L – Dartmouth had nine goals at Yale. It was the most for Dartmouth this season. Against the Bulldogs this year Dartmouth has scored 15 goals.

STILL MORE G-O-A-L-S – Dartmouth scored seven goals against Vermont on Jan. 2. It was the most goals scored against the Catamounts since an 11-4 Big Green victory in 1993.

G-O-A-L-S AGAIN –The six goal margin in Game Two of the ECAC quarterfinals was the biggest margin of victory for the Big Green this season. Dartmouth's previous best was a 9-4 win over Yale on November 21.

THANKS COACH – The second game in the best of three between Dartmouth and Rensselaer resulted in a 6-0 shutout by the Big Green. The shutout was the second in ECAC playoff history for Dartmouth. The first came against Rensselaer on March 11, 1980, when current Dartmouth head coach Bob Gaudet was in goal for the Big Green. He made 23 saves that night as Dartmouth won, 8-0. The shutout on March 14, 2004 was only the third in the history of Dartmouth hockey during the postseason.

SHUT-OUT – Dartmouth recorded its first shut out of the season in a 3-0 defeat of Brown on Feb. 27. In the game Nathan Szymanski had the game winner while Mike Ouellette and Brian Van Abel scored empty netters, the first time since Nov. 16, 2002 that has happened for the Big Green.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING – Freshman Dan Shribman knotted his first collegiate goal against St. Lawrence on Jan. 17. Another first year player, Tanner Glass, struck gold with his first collegiate strike against Maine on Dec. 13. Mike Hartwick and Rob Jarvis have both potted their first collegiate assists.

SECOND TIME FOR EVERYTHING – New Hampshire's 5-0 win over Dartmouth on Jan. 13 was the first time the Big Green has been shut out since Union stopped the Big Green, 2-0, in Thompson Arena on January 24, 2003. Union came up big again against Dartmouth, recording a 7-0 shutout on Jan. 31. The most recent was Harvard on Feb. 28 as they blanked Dartmouth, 4-0.



IN A CLASS ALL BY THEMSELVES – The Class of 2006 made an immediate impact in 2003. The class of nine student-athletes finished as the highest scoring rookie classes in the ECAC and the NCAA. They recorded 141 points (61g, 80a) in 34 games, making up 40.6 percent of the Big Green's offense. This season the '06 class has **113** of Dartmouth's **244** points (49g, 64a). Underclassmen make up 65% of Dartmouth's scoring (158-of-244).

YOU RANK 'EM – Dartmouth earned its first national ranking of the year when the Big Green entered the November 24 poll in the No. 11 spot. It was the highest ranking for the Big Green.

RANKED OPPONENTS – Dartmouth has gone 1-3-4 against ranked opponents this season, defeating Cornell, tying Harvard, BU, UMass and Colgate while losing to Boston College, Maine and New Hampshire.

FRESHMAN PHENOM – Freshman Grant Lewis finished the regular season tied for second in the ECAC for defenseman scoring and is second for freshman scoring. Nationally, he is 22nd in assists per game, fifth in defenseman points per game and is tied for 14th in rookie points per game. He currently has 25 points (3g, 22a).
