PARKING

The College has 2,508 spaces for employees and 1,102 spaces for students, the latter including spaces privately owned by coed clubs, fraternities and sororities. This total of 3,610 includes a recent very large increase due to the newly available parking on the former hospital site.

With this hospital site parking, the distribution of spaces has changed. The trend to replace small, close-in lots with larger, more remote lots continues. Since 1989, spaces have been eliminated at Mass Row, on Elm Street, behind Bradley Gerry and on the sites of Burke and Moore. Thus parking at the core continues to be a source of friction. Enforcement, with substantial fines, has been effective, with 10,000 tickets issued annually. Yet this number of infractions can be interpreted as a sign of a faulty system.

A shuttle system serves the remote lots. In the long-term, this system will be the key to the success of remote parking. For the system to work better, the vans should increase their headway to five minutes from its current 20 - 30 minutes.

The numbers of cars registered on campus continues to increase. College non-Medical School employees registered 2,351 cars for which there are 2,508 spaces. Medical School employees registered 517 cars for which there are 717 spaces. Students registered 1,661 cars for which there are 1,102 spaces.

With these numbers, the future for parking at Dartmouth is well in view: a very limited number of close-in spaces, more remote lots, and, we trust, an effective shuttle. Thus the long-term development of the land north of Berry Library, marked (?) on this map, should include parking. Utilities on this site have been set to allow construction of a sunken 2-floor, 200-car garage, with a plaza at grade and academic buildings above. Though costly, we highly recommend this solution. The College has few appropriate sites left for close-in parking. A garage here will allow much greater freedom for the development of the hospital site.
