

## **FAQs for Interim Housing**

### ***What is interim housing?***

Interim housing is housing available to you after residence halls close at the end of each term. Interim housing is provided at no additional cost.

### ***If my roommate has interim do I need to apply?***

Yes, anyone that needs to stay past closing day must apply for interim housing, even if you only need it for one day. Interim approval is by student, not by room. If you do not have approved interim housing and you are staying in a college-owned building after we close you are trespassing and could be sanctioned.

### ***Where is the interim application?***

The interim application can be found on Bannerstudent under Housing StarPortal.

### ***Do I need a reason to stay on campus during the interim?***

Yes, you must be: working on campus, be a BE finishing work for a class, live 500 miles or more away from campus, or be conducting research on campus. If you are working or conducting research we must receive a blitz from your employer or research sponsor confirming your work with them. Your application will not be processed until we have received an email from your employer, sponsor, or professor.

### ***Do I need to apply for interim if I live in a sorority, fraternity or affinity?***

Yes, if you live in a college-owned building then you need to apply for interim housing.

If you live in a privately-owned building then you need to coordinate interim housing with your house manager and/or housing assignments coordinator.

### ***Can I stay in my current room?***

Yes, you will be assigned to your current room for the following interim periods:

Fall/Winter

Winter/Spring

Summer/Fall

**\*\*All students applying for spring/summer interim are assigned to the Choates and River clusters. The only exceptions are seniors and students living in the same room summer to fall.\*\***

### ***Do I need fall/winter interim housing for Thanksgiving?***

No, the college is open until December 11th at 12 noon.

### ***Can I apply for interim after the deadline?***

You can apply for late interim but there is a \$50 late fee. You must apply five business days before your arrival date.

### ***Can I stay for the entire interim if I am on for the following term?***

Yes, if your reason for staying meets the interim requirements.

### ***Can I stay for the entire interim if I am not on the following term?***

No, but you can request interim housing for up to 3 days after closing if you meet the requirements to stay.

### ***If I am an athlete do I need to apply for interim?***

No, varsity athletes participating in college-approved practice during the interim period must coordinate interim housing through their coach and/or the Department of Athletics. Athletes are subject to the same eligibility requirement for interim periods, including move in and out dates, as non-athletes.

### ***If I am an athlete participating in Club Sports do I need to apply?***

Yes.

**SPRING/SUMMER INTERIM ONLY**

*Can I stay to see a friend graduate?*

If you are working on campus, live 500 miles or more away or conducting research, yes. You will not be approved for interim if your only reason is to see someone graduate.

**SUMMER/FALL INTERIM ONLY**

*If I am a DOC trip leader do I need to apply?*

Yes

*If I am a DOC trip leader and I am not on for the following term can I get interim housing?*

No, you must have on campus housing for the next term to be eligible for interim.
