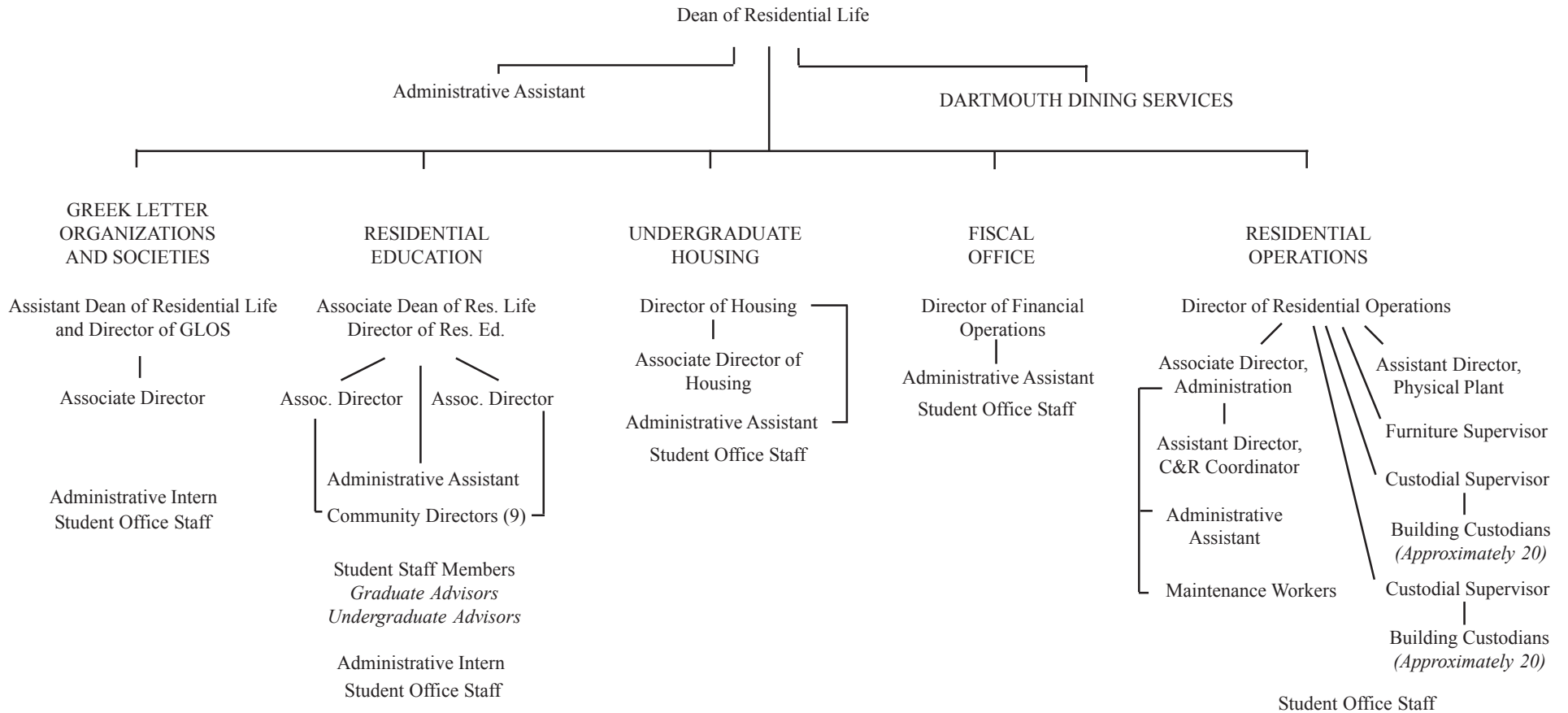


**Dartmouth College Office of Residential Life

Greek Letter Organizations and Societies is responsible for leadership development, organizational management and general administration for all Greek Letter and Senior Society organizations at Dartmouth College.

Residential Education is responsible for hall programs and student staff selection, training and evaluation. They conduct diversity, education and outreach initiatives and provide counseling, advising, and mediation & referral resources for all students in residence.

The Housing Office assigns rooms to undergraduates and distributes keys. They develop policies and procedures related to the housing assignment process.

The Fiscal Office's primary responsibilities include overseeing all financial and human resource issues for the Office of Residential Life.

Residential Operations oversees building maintenance and repair programs. They are responsible for custodial services, room and furniture inventory systems, and storage within the undergraduate residential facilities. They also manage Commencement & Reunion housing and residence hall construction and renovation projects.
