RE: Housing Information for your anticipated return to campus

Dartmouth Students applying for readmission must complete either the Upper-class or First-year Student Readmit Application in order to receive on-campus housing. The application should be completed and submitted to the Office of Residential Life's Undergraduate Housing Office by the housing deadline for the term for which you are petitioning to return to campus. The applications are available on our website (www.dartmouth.edu/~orl/housing/forms).

IMPORTANT: When completing the housing application, you must attach a letter stating that you are applying for housing **in anticipation** of your receiving permission to return to the College. *Do not wait to apply for housing until after a decision is reached on your readmission as applying for housing after the application deadline will seriously jeopardize your chances of receiving a room on campus.*

REMEMBER! It is critical that your completed housing application and attached letter be submitted by the deadline for the term you anticipate returning, even if your readmission has not been approved when you send in the application. If we have not received your housing application and letter by the deadline, we cannot guarantee that an on-campus space can be held for you.

Students with first-year status are guaranteed housing if their applications are received by the appropriate deadline. Application received after the deadline is not guaranteed and will be housed on a space available basis.

Not all residence hall buildings are available during summer terms. Available summer buildings for 2009 are Hitchcock, Mass Row, New Hampshire & Channing Cox apartments.

Housing Deadlines:

Spring 2008: Tuesday, February 10, 2009

Summer 2008: Friday, May 15, 2009

Fall 2009: Monday, June 1, 2009 (application will be processed with all on-time waitlist applicants)

Winter 2010: Wednesday, October 28, 2009

Spring 2010: Monday, February 8, 2010

If you hope to return for Fall 2009 you must submit your readmitted student application by the June 1, 2009 waitlist application deadline. Student seeking readmission for fall are not eligible to participate in Room Draw or have a proxy select at room at Room Draw on their behalf.
