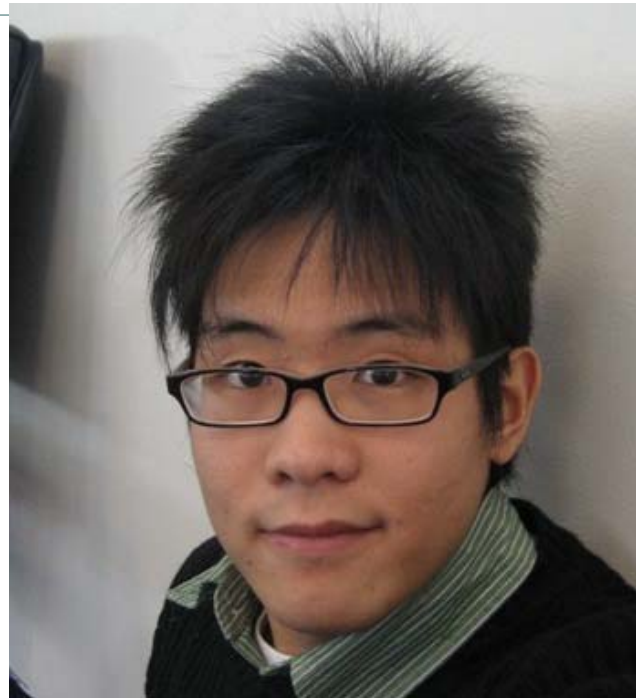


BE A UGA!
