



Dartmouth General Fellowships
and
William Hill Memorial Loans

These awards are granted for graduate study or projects either in the U.S. or abroad. In addition to the usual one-year awards, smaller amounts may be granted in support of short-term off-campus projects. Awards are made with consideration of the soundness of the proposed program, the applicant's academic merit, and his or her financial need. Preference is given to graduating seniors and to alumni/ae beginning their first year of graduate study. Applications for law and business schools are discouraged; applications for medical school are not accepted. The total award does not normally exceed \$2,000 to \$3,000, and the amount of the fellowship or low cost (3%) loan may vary, taking into account the applicant's need and other available sources of support, such as fellowships and assistantships from graduate schools. Awards are for one year only and are not renewable. Students who have previously received a Dartmouth Reynolds Scholarship are ineligible.

Instructions for Applicants

The deadline for completed applications (including budget, transcript and recommendations) is **Wednesday, March 9, 2005**. All materials may be returned to Scholarship Advising, 9A Parkhurst Hall, HB 6003, Dartmouth College, Hanover, N.H. 03755.

Request a Dartmouth **transcript** from the Registrar's Office (4 McNutt Hall) and transcripts from all other institutions at which you have studied.

Request **three letters of recommendation**, at least two of which should be from Dartmouth instructors who know your work well. Experience has shown that its best to collect these yourself in signed envelope and submit with your application and transcript

Applicants must **submit a detailed budget** for their proposed study or project. Include, in addition to your anticipated expenses, any other support you have requested and/or received, as well as any personal assets you can contribute.
