**Five** additional Sociology courses numbered 10 or higher. Students must take must take three Lower Division courses (numbered 20-49), one Upper Division course (numbered 50-80), and one Culminating Experience course (see below). Students may substitute an Upper Division course for one of the Lower Division courses. Majors are encouraged to identify an area of concentration within Sociology. **Culminating Experience:** Standard and modified majors must satisfy the *culminating experience* requirement by successfully completing any one of the following three options: *Senior Independent Study Project* (Sociology 90), *The Sociological Imagination* (Sociology 91), or *Honors Thesis* (Sociology 98). Because only one term of Sociology 98 counts as one of the seven additional courses numbered 10 or higher that are required for completion of the major, taking a second term of Sociology 98 means that Honor students will typically take an extra course credit in sociology.
