## Dartmouth Brain Imaging Center: Non-Dartmouth Research Participant Information Sheet

#### **General information**

As vaccination coverage increases nationally and locally and COVID-19 case rates decrease, Dartmouth is allowing visitors including research participants to come to campus. Dartmouth policies may be more restrictive than federal, state, or local guidance. Visitors are people who do not work, reside, or attend school at Dartmouth, and who do not have a current business or academic relationship with Dartmouth. This includes alumni and students who are not already registered to be on campus, as well as research participants in studies conducted in the Dartmouth Brain Imaging Center (DBIC).

### **Visitor Requirements: General Access**

Regardless of vaccination status, all research participants are asked to follow <u>state and local requirements</u> and Dartmouth policies including, but not limited to, wearing a face covering.

# Please do not participate in the research study or come to the Dartmouth Brain Imaging Center (DBIC) if:

- you have been directed by a public health official to quarantine or isolate during the period you are scheduled for research participation
- you are not fully vaccinated and have traveled outside New England in the last 10 days.
- you are experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19 including the following:
  - o A fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher, or felt feverish in the last 72 hours
  - New respiratory symptoms including a runny nose, nasal congestion, sore throat, cough, or shortness of breath
  - General body symptoms such as new muscle aches, chills, or severe fatigue
  - New gastrointestinal symptoms such as nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
  - Any new change in sense of taste or smell

### Research team contract tracing obligation

If you develop symptoms or test positive for COVID-19 while in the DBIC, or within 48 hours of study participation, please inform the study team. For any visitor testing positive or developing symptoms, the study team is required to notify the College of the places they spent time and the and people they were within 6 feet of for a cumulative time of 10 minutes or longer. The study team will **not** share your name or any other personally identifiable information. The information you provide will not be connected to the study data.
