**SOP:
Title: Removal of Transite Panels,
Siding, Shingles.**

{29 CFR 1926.1101(8)(iii)},{29 CFR 1926.1101(9)(iv)},{Env-C 404.03}

Purpose: Proper removal of transite panels, siding, shingles in compliance with Dartmouth College Policy.

Scope: All Dartmouth College Employees

Responsibilities:

- Supervisors will inform EHS when asbestos material is being removed.
- Supervisors will not ask employees who have not been trained to remove asbestos material.
- Workers must have successfully completed a 16 hour training course. And 8 hour annual refresher training.
- EHS will conduct air and bulk sampling and Negative Exposure Assessments as necessary.

Procedure:

- Workers must have successfully completed a 16 hour training course. And 4 hour refresher training annually.
- Cutting, abrading or breaking shall be prohibited.
- Each panel shall be sprayed with amended water prior to removal.
- Nails shall be cut with sharp, flat instruments. Dust suppression methods shall be used during disassembly.
- Panels must be wrapped in 2 layers of 6 mil. plastic sheeting or impervious waste bags and labeled no later than the end of the workday.
- Contact EHS to arrange pick up and disposal.
- All waste must be disposed of in landfills approved for acceptance of asbestos waste and packaged to the specifications established by the individual landfill.
