Export Still Frames From Video



You can export still frames as JPEG files from a DVD, video file, or iMovie project using iSkysoft iMedia Converter. The software is available at the Jones Media Center Editing Stations.

1. Open iSkysoft iMedia Converter by clicking the icon in the dock.
2. To import media, drag and drop the video file or DVD disk icon directly to the iSkysoft iMedia Converter window. Note: You can also import video by selecting **Load Media Files** or **Load DVD Files** from the file menu.
3. To import video directly from **iMovie**, click the **Open Media Browser** button  in the top right corner and select the **Video** tab.
4. Navigate to the iMovie Event Library and select a specific event and video file. Click the **PLUS** button to load the file.
5. In the iSkysoft main window, click the pencil button  for the clip that contains the image you want to export. iSkysoft will switch to **Edit** mode.
6. Navigate to the frame you want to capture using the scrubber bar at the bottom of the window.
7. Click the **Snapshot** button in the lower left corner to capture the image.
8. Still frames are automatically saved as JPEG files. A pop-up window lets you easily navigate to the image file, located in the *public user > Pictures > iSkysoft iMedia Converter Deluxe* folder.
