
## iSkysoft iMedia Converter

## Capture Clips from a DVD




- 1. Insert the disc into the Mac DVD drive. If the DVD automatically begins playing, exit the DVD player program.
- 2. Open iSkysoft iMedia Converter Deluxe by clicking the icon in the dock and select **Video** as the output option.



- 3. A prompt will appear asking if you want to load the DVD. Click **OK**. The imported files appear listed in the window with respective thumbnails. Note: You can also import video by dragging the files or DVD disk icon directly to the iMedia Converter window.
- 4. To import selected clips from the disc, click the green pencil icon. iSkysoft will switch to **Edit** mode.



5. Navigate the playhead to a particular scene and click the scissors icon. Set the in/out points for your clip by dragging the two markers in the timeline.



- 6. To import multiple clips, repeat step 5. Click **Done** to return to the main Converter screen.
- 7. Click the format icon next to the green pencil icon to open the output format list. Choose a video format from the drop-down list. If you plan to use the clip in an iMovie project, select the **iMovie** preset listed under **Apple Software**.
- After you enter the settings, click the Convert button to start the conversion process. This
  may take several minutes. iSkysoft places converted files in the Video Converted folder
  (Movies > iSkysoft iMedia Converter Deluxe > Video Converted). The folder opens automatically after the conversion is finished.
