Export Still Frames From Video

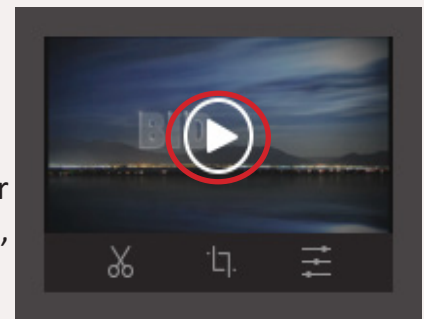


You can export still frames as JPEG files from a DVD, video file, or iMovie project using iSkysoft iMedia Converter. The software is available at the Jones Media Center Editing Stations.



1. Open iSkysoft iMedia Converter by clicking the icon in the dock.
2. To import media, drag and drop the video file to the iSkysoft iMedia Converter window. If you are importing from a DVD, insert the DVD in the computer or external drive. In the pop-up window **Do you want to load the following DVD**, click **OK**. You have a choice to either load **Main Movie Only** or **All Titles**. You can also import video by selecting **Load Media Files** or **Load DVD Files** from the file menu.

3. In the iSkysoft main window, click the play button in the clip that contains the image you want to export. The **Edit** window will pop up.



4. Navigate to the frame you want to capture using the scrubber bar at the bottom of the window. To capture the exact frame, use the LEFT and RIGHT arrow keys on the keyboard.



5. Click the **Snapshot** button and select **Set Snapshot Folder**. Choose the location where you want to save your still frames (e.g., the desktop).

6. Click the the **Snapshot** button and then select **Snapshot** to take a picture of the selected frame.
