
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#### Reports

- 9 Principles of Good Practice for Assessing Student Learning (1996)
  - 1. The assessment of student learning begins with educational values.
  - 2. Assessment is most effective when it reflects an understanding of learning as multidimensional, integrated, and revealed in performance over time.
  - Assessment works best when the programs it seeks to improve have clear, explicitly stated purposes.
  - Assessment requires attention to outcomes but also and equally to the experiences that lead to those outcomes.
  - 5. Assessment works best when it is ongoing not episodic.
  - Assessment fosters wider improvement when representatives from across the educational community are involved.
  - 7. Assessment makes a difference when it begins with issues of use and illuminates questions that people really care about.
  - 8. Assessment is most likely to lead to improvement when it is part of a larger set of conditions that promote change.
  - Through assessment, educators meet responsibilities to students and to the public.
