P Project	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Indicates the work being done Has 6 numeric digits Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Insulin Regulation Bioinformatics Mascoma Clinic <p>Note: All projects are numbered within 500000-589999 range</p>
T Task	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides a mechanism for organizing expenditures within a project Has 4 numeric digits Organizes expenses within a project Current task ranges: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 5000-5999 – funded by an external sponsor 6000-6999 – funded by internal cost share <p>Note: Each project must have at least one task</p>
A Award	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describes the money paying for the work being done Has 6 alpha-numeric characters Begins with an alpha character, which identifies the billing mechanism to allow efficient processing of sponsor invoices <ul style="list-style-type: none"> L - Letter of credit B - Billed monthly and quarterly P - Payment/Installment Schedule C - Cost Share
E Expenditure Type	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Is a subset of the GL Expense Natural Class list Has 5 alpha-numeric characters Has an Alpha character at end of the four digits to provide flexibility when greater detail is needed in OGA (such as subcontractor payments) Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 7471A SUPPL LAB Chemical Gases 8111A TRAVEL FOREIGN Air 7785A SUBRECIPIENT (Dept will track who Subrecipient A is.) 7785B SUBRECIPIENT (Dept will track who Subrecipient B is.)
O Org	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Is the same as GL Org value Has 3 numeric digits <p>Note: Some Oracle modules, such as Accounts Payable, Labor Distribution, Procurement, accept name in place of Org value</p>

What is PTAE0?	PTAE0 is a unique chart string that is used to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Record sponsored-project financial transactions • Specify details about transactions • Report on transactions • Allocate and track sponsored-project budgets
PTAE0 Strings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5 segments separated by periods make a PTAE0 string • Total of 24 characters in a PTAE0 string – alpha and numeric • Every transaction must have a complete PTAE0 string • Each segment represents a different piece of information • No hierarchies or range values with PTAE0
PTAE0 Samples	<p>Sample PTAE0 in Thayer: 501381.5000.L00475.7571A.842</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"> Project: Smart Laser Beams (501381) Task: External Funding (5000) Award: Smart Laser Beams (L00475) Expenditure Type: CAP EQUIP Scientific (7571A) Org: Mechanical Thayer (842) </p> <p>Sample PTAE0 in Arts & Sciences: 500681.5000.B00051.6012A.472</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"> Project: From Cells to Solids (500681) Task: External Funding (5000) Award: From Cells to Solids (B00051) Expenditure Type: FAC REG Tenure (6012A) Org: Physics & Astronomy (472) </p>
OGA is a Validation Engine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mandates valid PTAE0 string combinations • Restricts upload of invalid combinations • Results in failed transaction entries if combinations are invalid
OGA Validation Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each PTAE0 must have a <u>valid</u> Project-Task-Award combination • Each PTAE0 must have a <u>valid</u> Expenditure Type for Project, Task or Award • Transaction date <u>must</u> fall between the start and end dates of the Project, Task, or Award • Project status <u>must</u> allow transactions • Award status <u>must</u> allow transactions
Task-Award Relationship Clues	<p>Tasks that begin with a “5” are funded by an external sponsor, and are always linked with an Award that begins with these specific alpha characters indicating how it is billed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ L (Letter of Credit) ○ B (Billed monthly or quarterly) ○ P (Payment/Installment Schedule) <p>Example: 501381.5000.L00475.7571A.842</p> <p>Tasks that begin with a “6” are funded by internal cost share, and are always linked with an Award that begins with a C to indicate Cost Share billing.</p> <p>Example: 500682.6000.C00523.7571A.842</p>

<p>PTAEO allows several types of relationships among Projects, Tasks, and Awards.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Single Project, Single Award</p>  <pre> graph LR P[Project 500001] --> T[Task 5000] T --> A[Award L12345] </pre>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Single Project, Multiple Awards</p>  <pre> graph LR P[Project 500001] --> T1[Task 5000] P --> T2[Task 6000] T1 --> A1[Award L12345] T2 --> A2[Award C12345] </pre>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Multiple Projects, Single Award</p>  <pre> graph LR P1[Project 500001] --> T1[Task 5000] P2[Project 500002] --> T2[Task 5000] P3[Project 500003] --> T3[Task 5000] T1 --> A[Award L12345] T2 --> A T3 --> A </pre>
