Office of Sponsored Projects Fiscal Year 2023 Annual Report

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Executive Summary

During fiscal year 2023, Dartmouth sponsored research awards, excluding financial aid, remained steady at \$170 million, an increase of 1.67% from fiscal year 2022. Expenses increased by half a percent, off trend or adjusting from more significant increases in fiscal years 2021 and 2022. Proposal costs increased significantly from fiscal year 2022, when one large FY22 outlier is excluded (\$290 million NASA proposal). Detailed analyses are available in the sections that follow this brief overview.

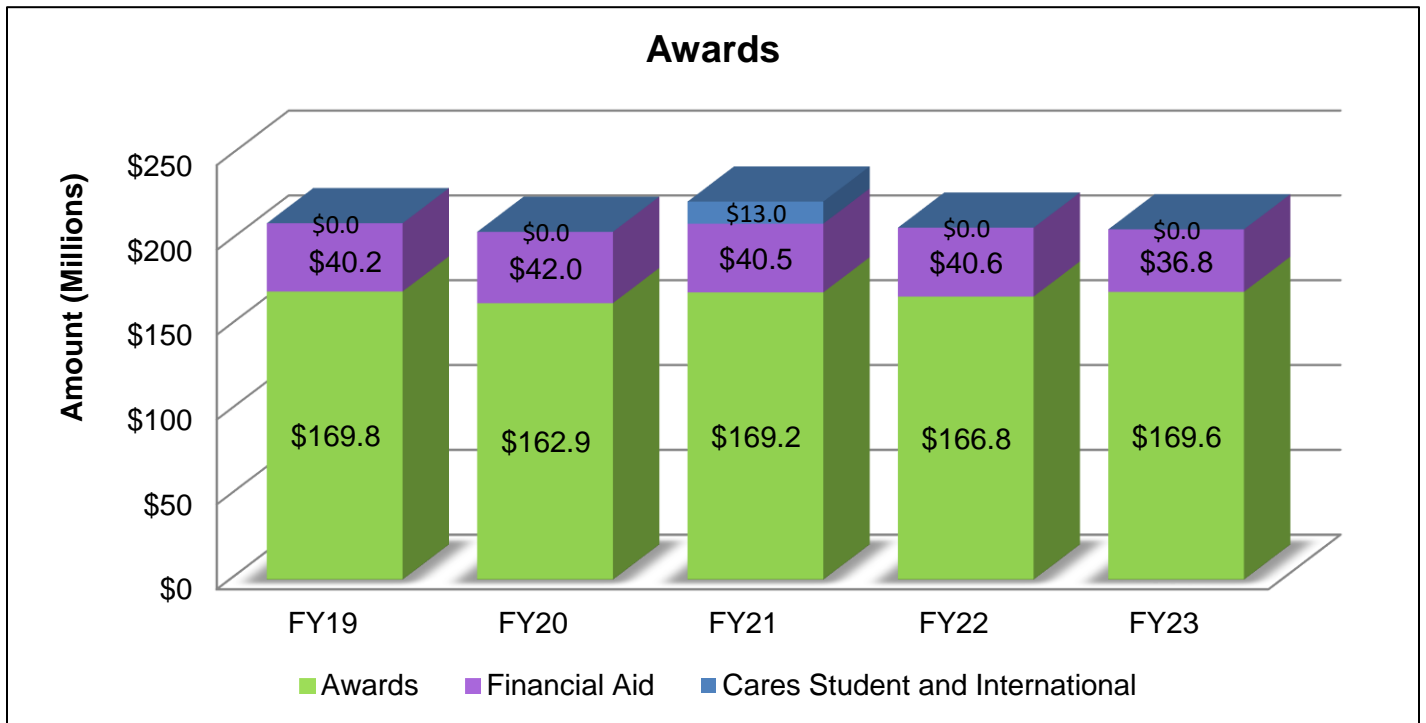


Awards

Dartmouth College received 713 award commitments in the fiscal year 2023, totaling \$169,586,361. An additional 36.8 million was received in financial aid. Through time, award dollars continue to trend upward. Slowly. Taking into consideration Geisel Medical School’s recent reorganization as well as the Covid-19 pandemic event, maintaining steady incoming award dollars can be viewed in a positive light. Both Arts & Sciences and Thayer Engineering saw noticeable rises in award income. Geisel School of Medicine saw a decrease of approximately 6%, believed to reflect continued adjustment to significant staff changes over the past five years.

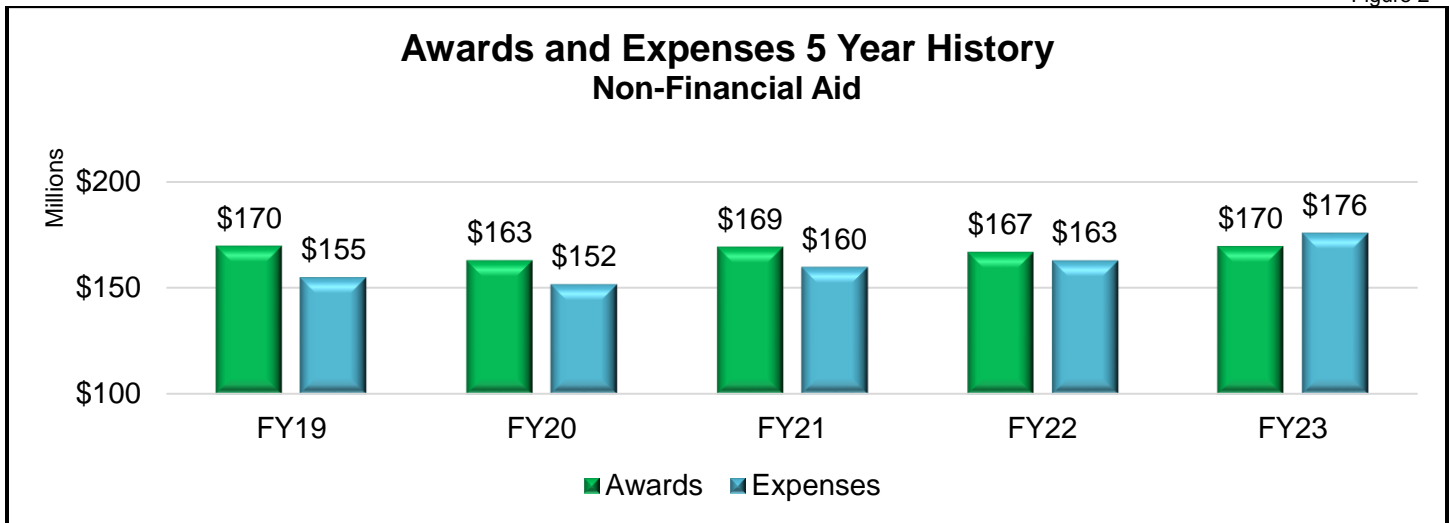
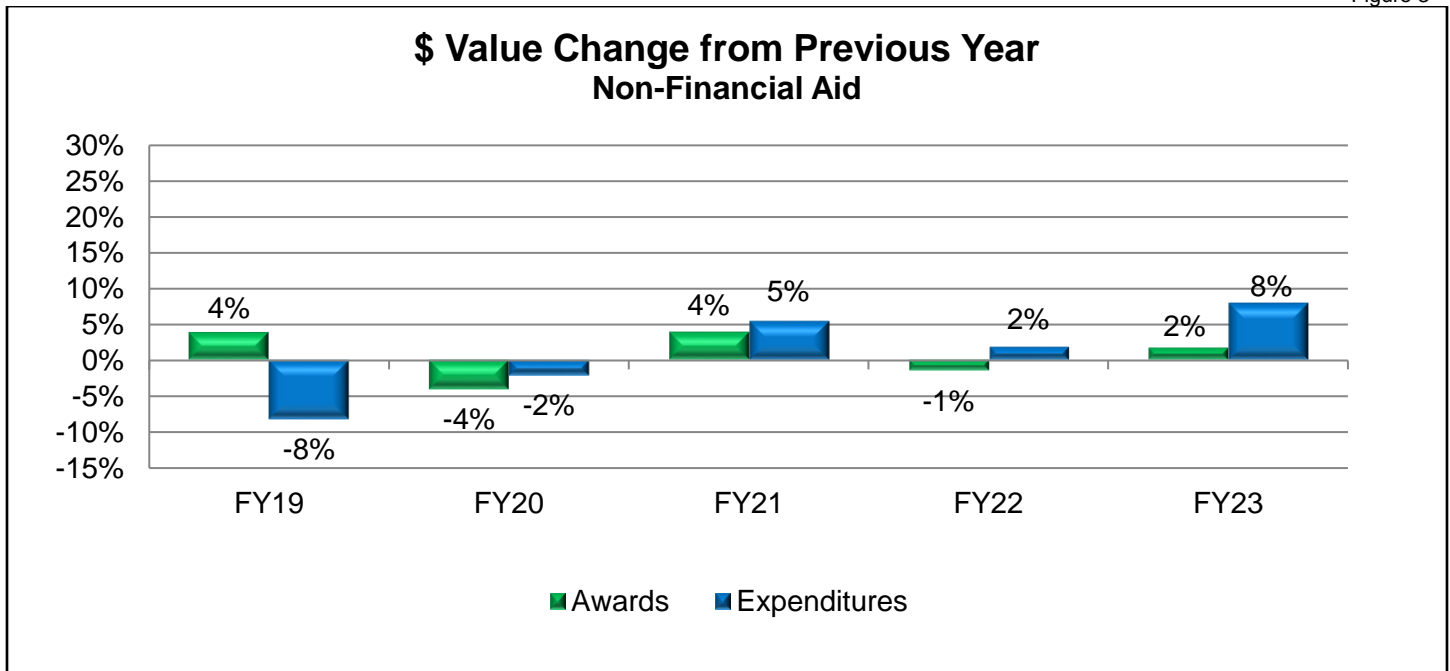


Figure 3 illustrates the relative changes in award and expenditure levels over the previous five years (Financial Aid excluded).

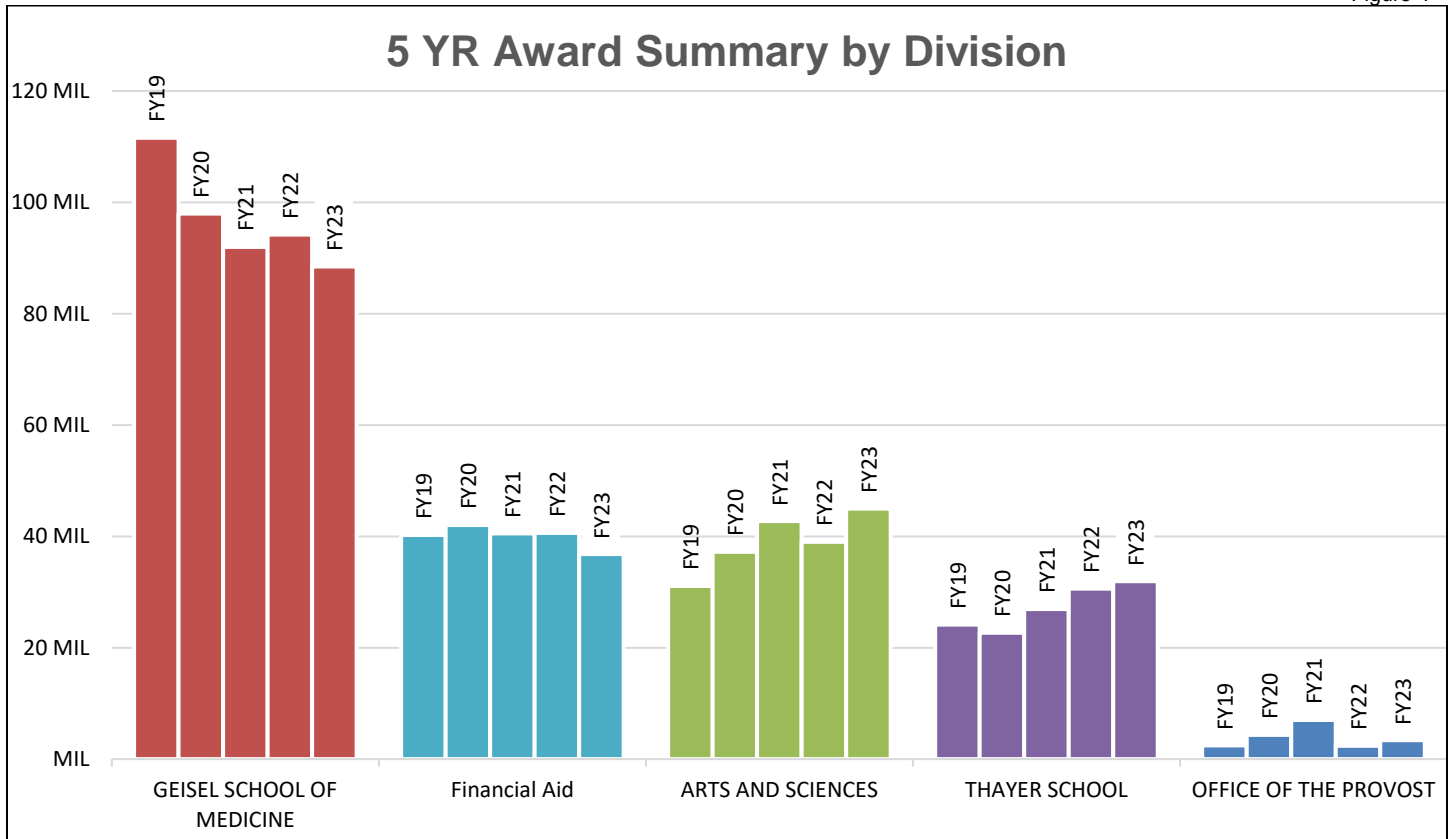

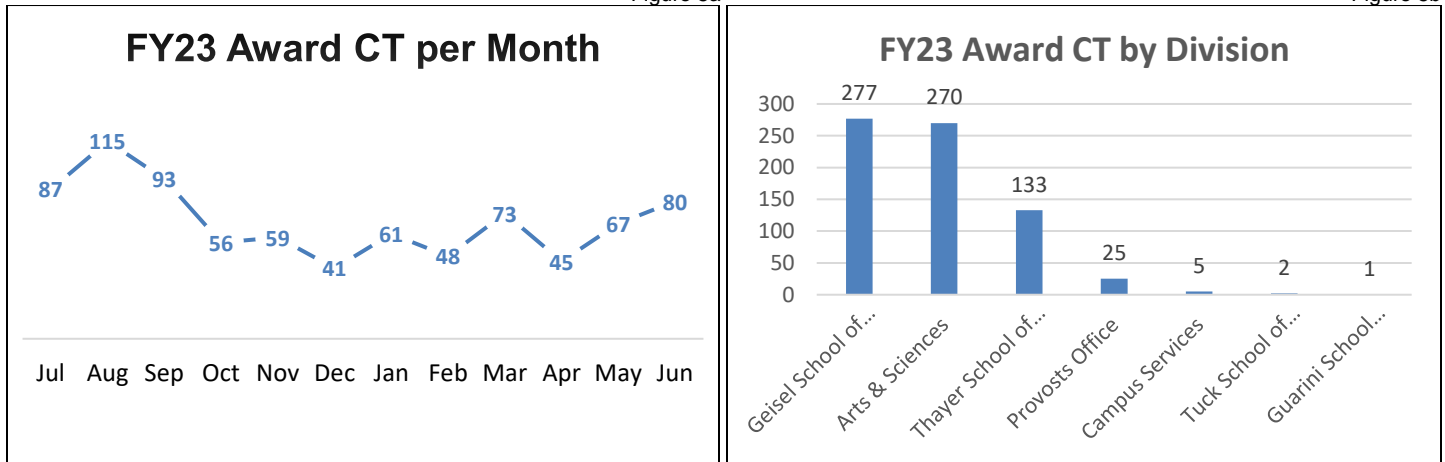

Award Funding Sources

As Figure 6 illustrates, Dartmouth College relies heavily upon government sponsored research. In fiscal year 2023, government awards totaled \$148,894,565 (88% of total), compared to \$18,973,620 (11%) in private funding and \$1,718,176 (1%) in foreign funding. Government awards decreased 1%, from fiscal year 2022. Private awards increased by 25% over fiscal year 2022 totals.

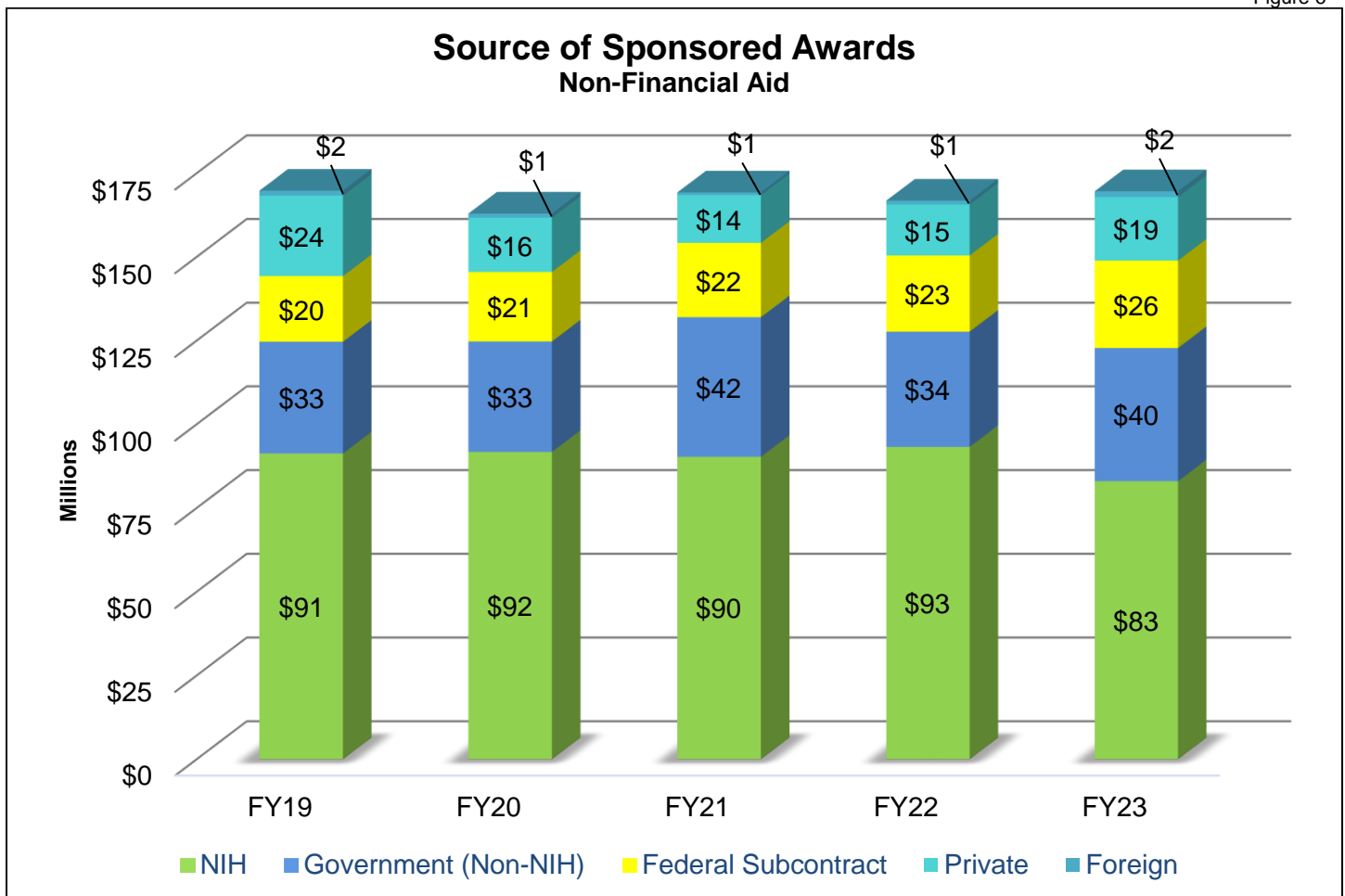

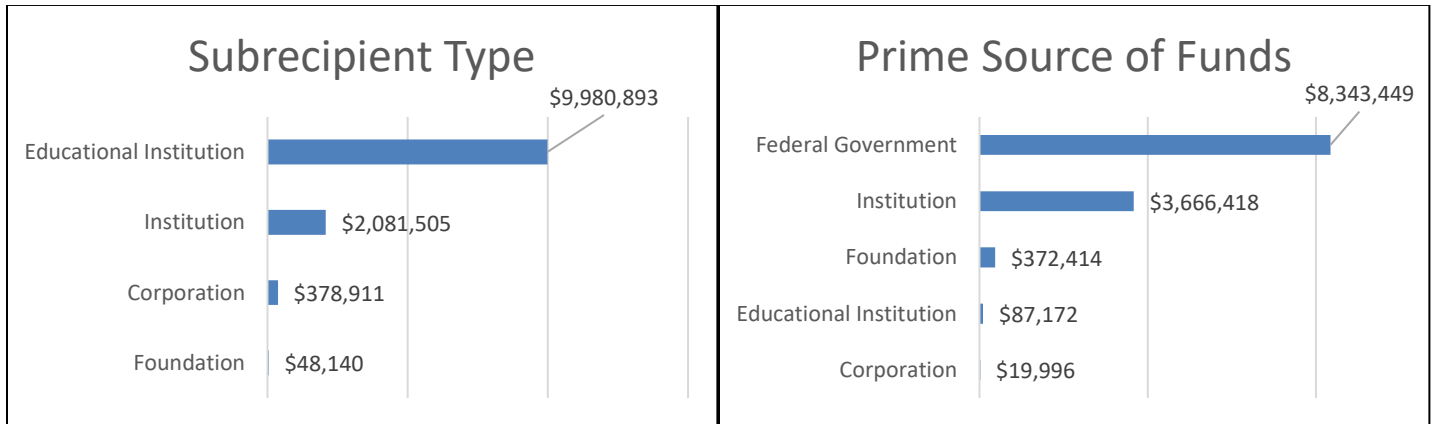

Proposals

Dartmouth College faculty and staff submitted 845 proposals totaling \$802,951,388 during fiscal year 2023. Excluding a 2022 outlier, proposal amounts increased 19% and counts increased 4% from fiscal year 2022 to fiscal year 2023. It should be noted that proposal counts and amounts fluctuate more from year to year than do awards.

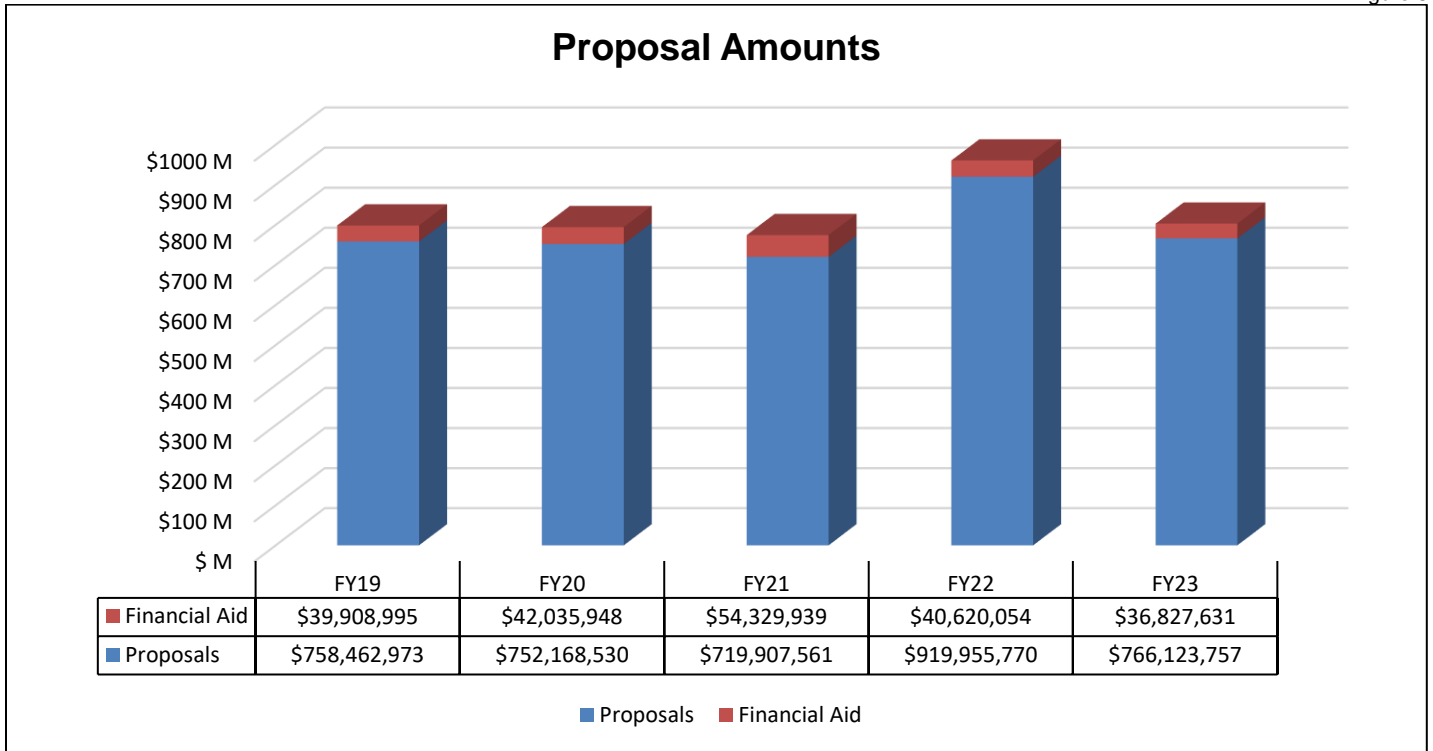

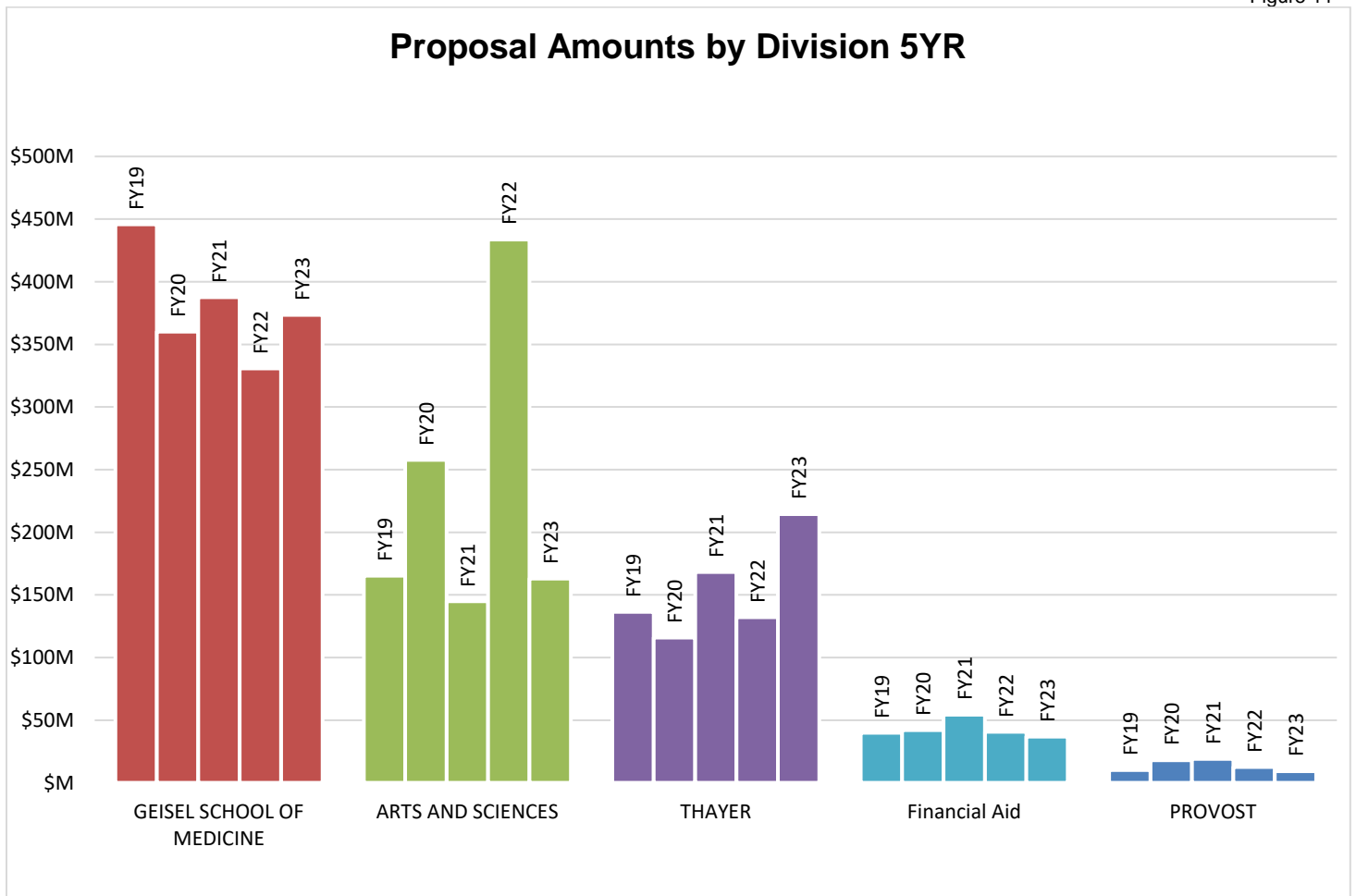

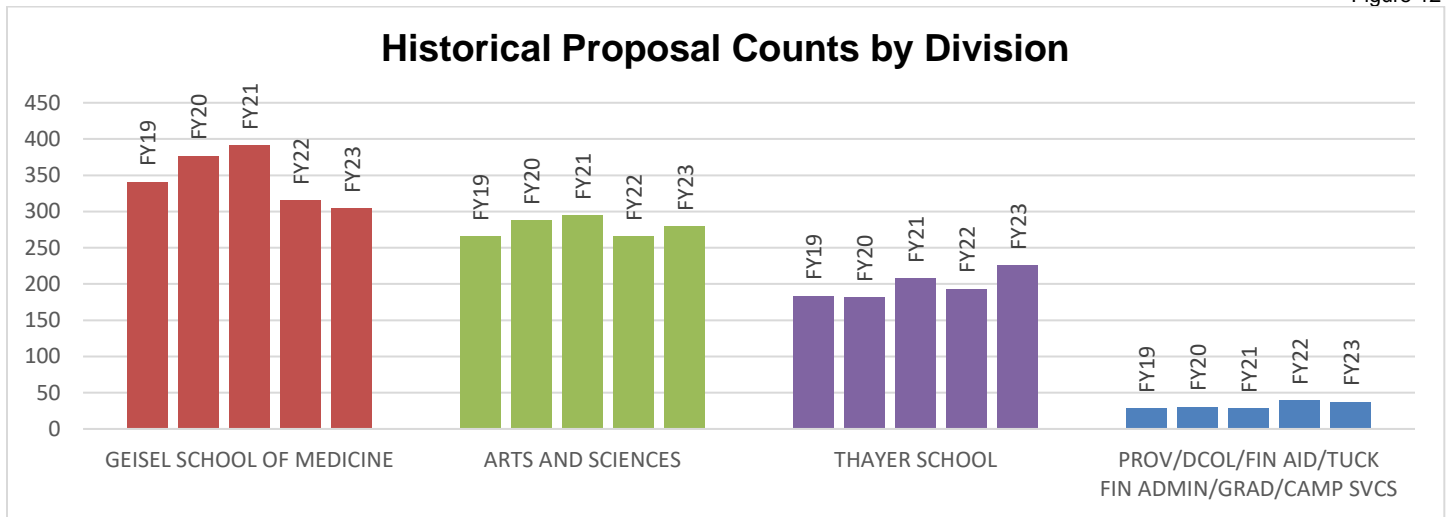

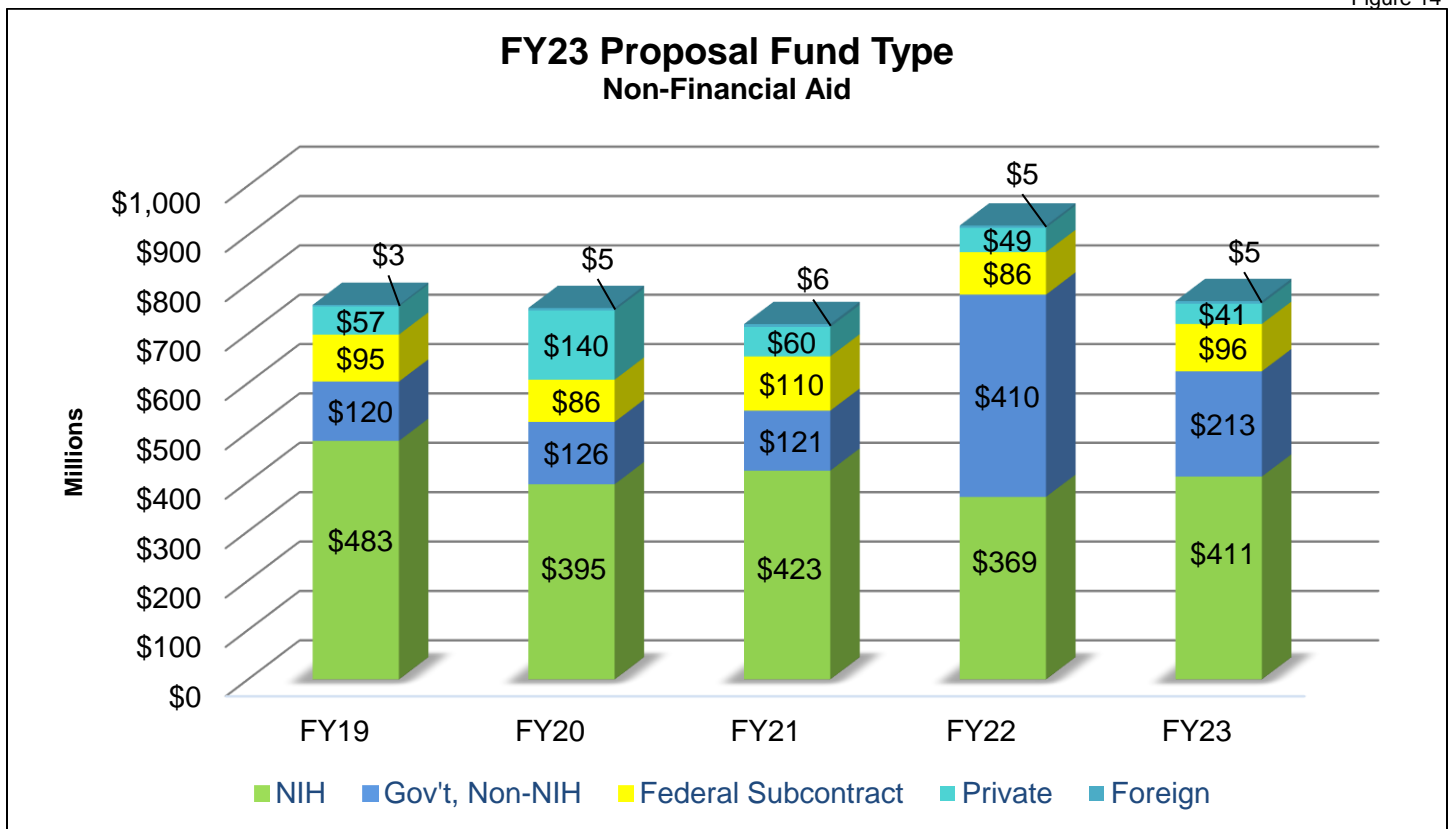

Sponsored research expenditures in fiscal year 2023 totaled \$212,699,883, a decrease of 4% from FY2022. Excluding financial aid, direct expenses increased 7% from fiscal year 2022.

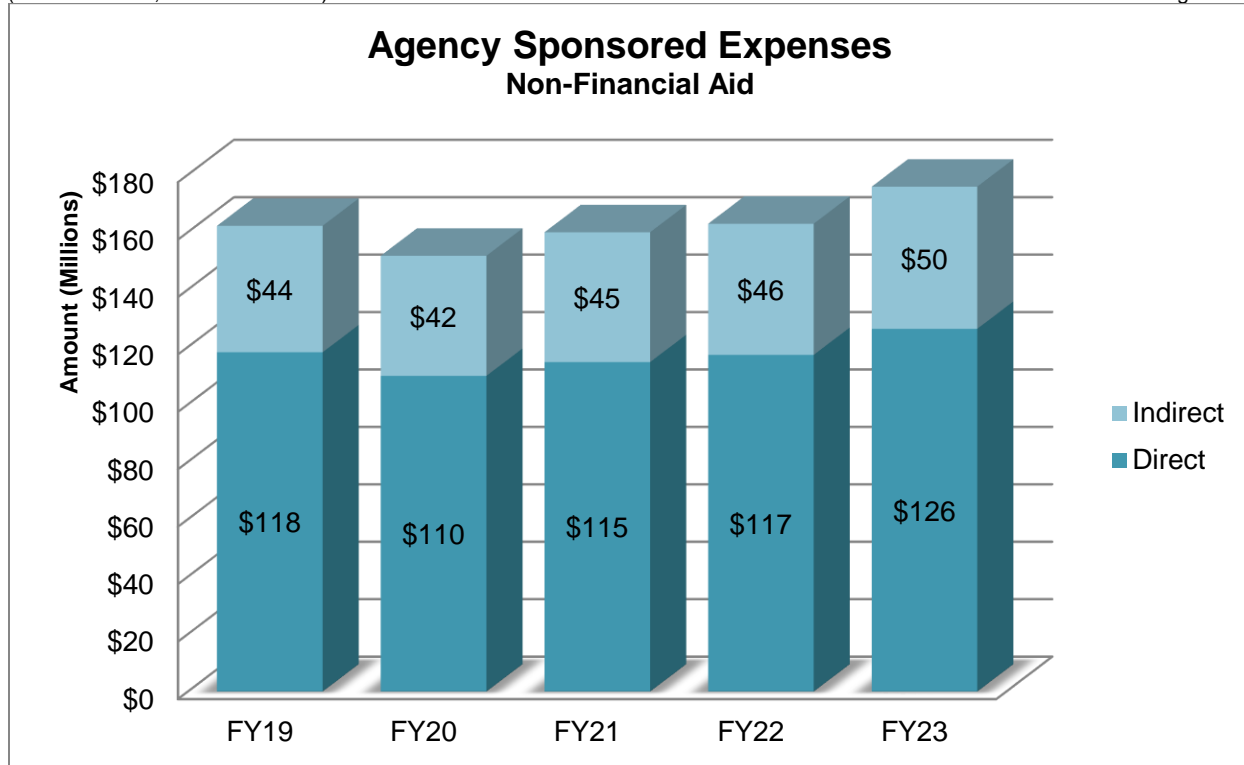

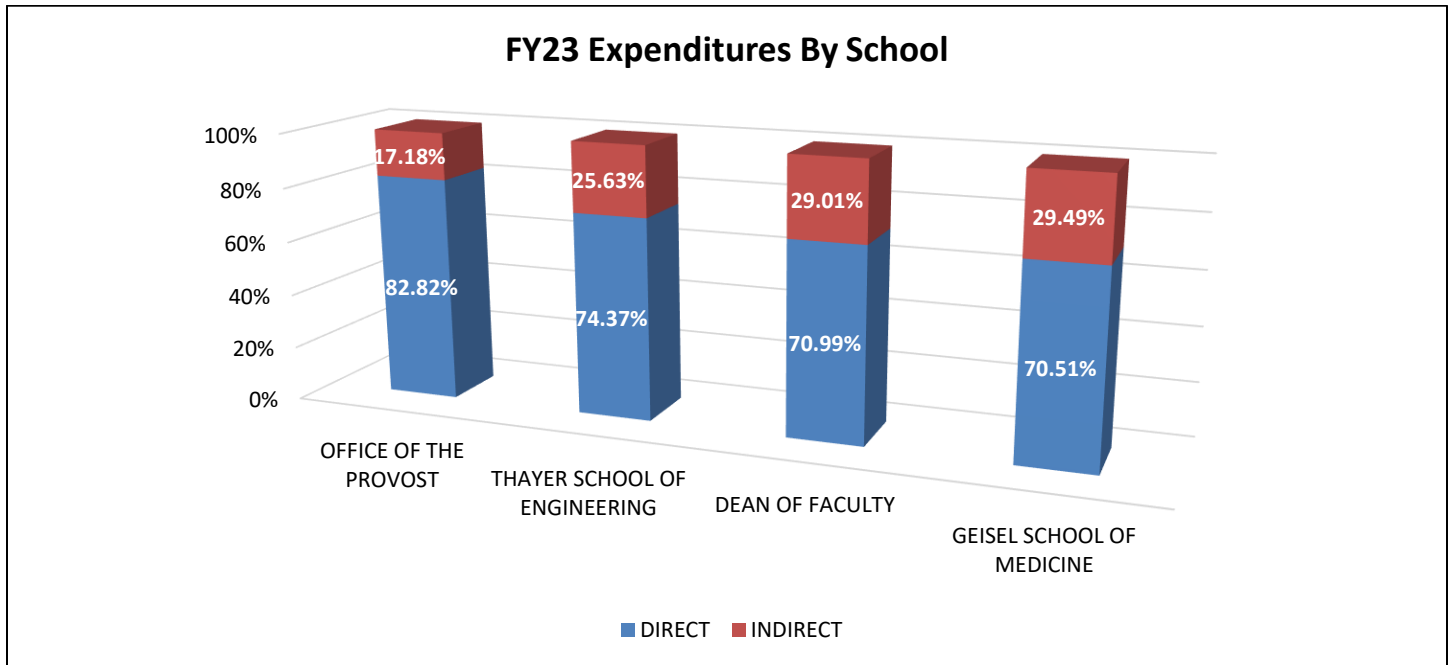

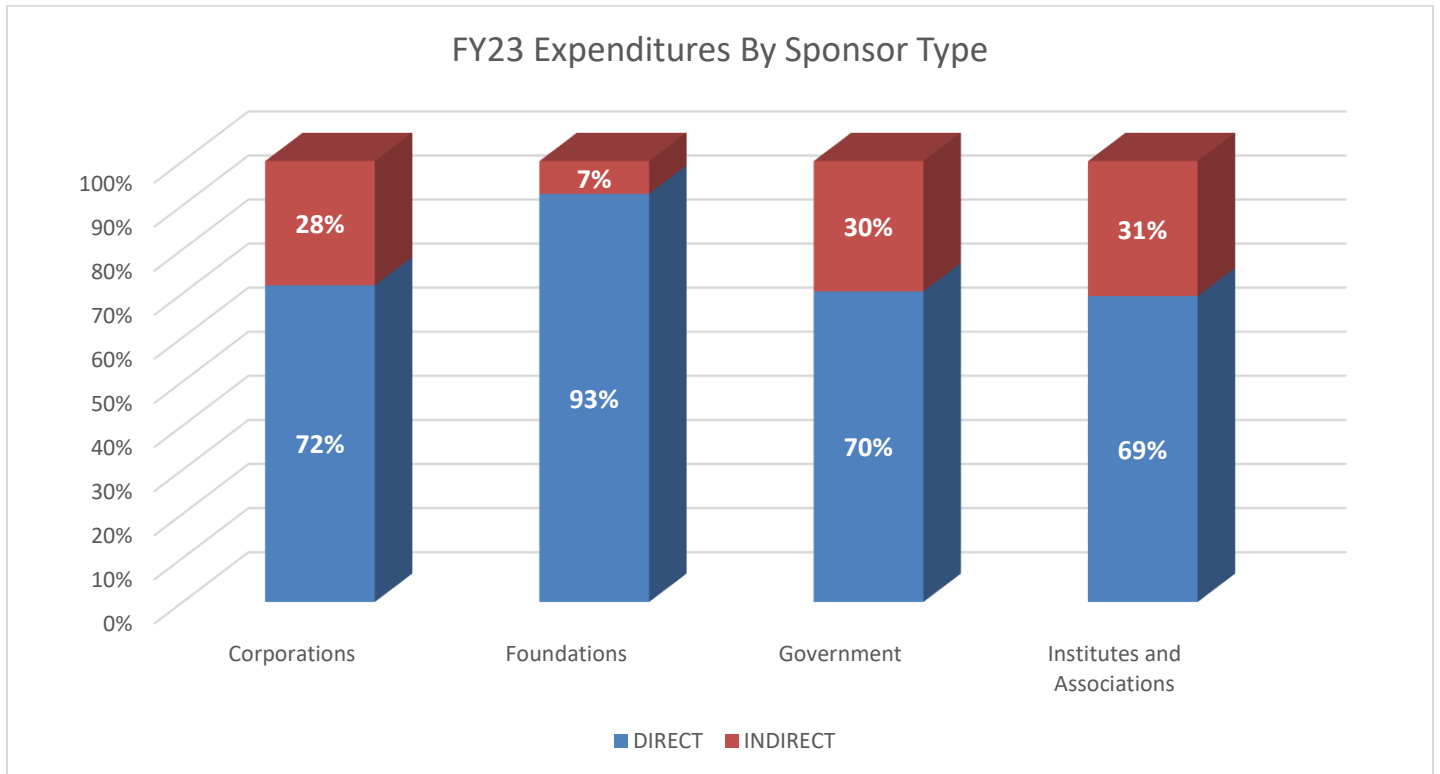
