## Important Major/Minor Policies

Minimum Courses Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Majors must include a minimum of 10 courses, including prerequisites.</li> <li>• Minors must include a minimum of 6 courses. 2 of the 6 credits may be prerequisites, but minors may include additional prerequisites.</li> <li>• Modified majors include a minimum of 10 courses, with at least 6 in the primary department and at least 4 in the secondary department</li> </ul>	<a href="#">Standard Departmental or Program Major</a>  <a href="#">The Minor</a>  <a href="#">Modified Major</a>
Maximum number of majors/minors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students may have a maximum of 3 total majors and minors. Note a student may not declare a minor until a major has been declared.</li> </ul>	<a href="#">The Major</a>
NRO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Courses that receive an NR grade cannot be used towards the major, except for:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Courses taken as prerequisites to the major</li> <li>○ Courses taken in 2020 summer term</li> </ul> </li> <li>• At most 1 course with an NR grade may count in the minor, including prerequisites and 2020 summer term courses.</li> </ul>	<a href="#">Non-Recording Option</a>  <a href="#">Summer 2020 NRO Policy</a>
CT/NC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Credit/no-credit courses may be counted towards the major/minor if approved by the department/program.</li> </ul>	<a href="#">Credit/No Credit Courses</a>
First-Year Seminars	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First-Year Seminars may not count towards the major</li> </ul>	<a href="#">Requirements for the Degree of Bachelor of Arts</a>
Using a course towards multiple majors/minors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A single course may not be used towards multiple majors/minors unless it is a prerequisite course to one or both majors/minors.</li> <li>• If a student attempts to count a course towards multiple majors/minors, the <i>DartWorks Dashboard</i> displays an error message.</li> </ul>	<a href="#">Multiple Majors</a>  <a href="#">The Minor</a>
Multiple majors/minors within a department/program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Multiple majors may not be within the same department or program, except when a department offers separate and dissimilar majors, as approved by the COI.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ See the <a href="#">list of invalid major/minor combinations</a>.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<a href="#">Multiple Majors</a>  <a href="#">The Minor</a>
Culminating Experience	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The culminating experience must be taken for credit and graded.</li> <li>• While departments/programs may make exceptions to their published major/minor requirements as they determine appropriate, an exception to the published major culminating experience must be approved by the Committee on Instruction.</li> <li>• If a student requests an exception to the Culminating Experience, contact <a href="mailto:Registrar@Dartmouth.edu">Registrar@Dartmouth.edu</a> for petition instructions.</li> </ul>	<a href="#">Culminating Experience in the Major</a>  <a href="#">The Major</a>
