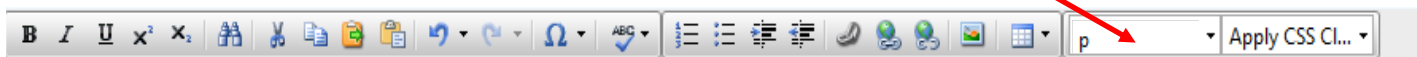


# Masthead/Requirements Section
