Parking Permit Renewal

This letter contains information about annual parking permit renewal for fiscal year July 1, 2019 - June 30, 2020. All vehicles, including motorcycles, that park on campus must register with Dartmouth Transportation Services and display a valid Dartmouth parking permit.

Renewal Instructions

It's easy to renew your annual parking permit on-line at Parking.Dartmouth.edu. At the Parking Portal click "Get Permits". Use your normal Dartmouth I.D. and password to login, then follow all directions carefully. For a tutorial search "Transportation Services" from the Dartmouth homepage and click on "Permit Renewal Tutorials". In the event that you do not have computer access to renew online, please visit the Transportation Services office located in the basement of 1953 Commons for assistance.

Payment Options

Payroll Deduction: When renewing your permit online at Parking.Dartmouth.edu, choose "payroll deduction" as your payment option if you prefer the annual permit amount to be deducted on a pro-rated basis from your bi-weekly or monthly payroll.

Full-Year Payment: Pay with a credit card at Parking.Dartmouth.edu for the annual amount listed below.

Deadline Instructions and Important Information

Renewal deadline is June 29, 2019. Outstanding parking citations must be paid prior to permit renewal. Personal permit type eligibility will display during the online process and a waitlist is available for upgrade opportunities.

FACULTY AND STAFF PARKING OPTIONS

When signing into your personal parking account online at Parking.Dartmouth.edu, permit options available to you will display. These options may include:

Green Permit: Allows access to all Faculty/Staff lots. Renewal is limited to current green permit holders (30-days eligibility grace to renew after expiration). Individuals interested in upgrading to a green permit should join the seniority based waitlist at Parking.Dartmouth.edu.

Tan Permit: Allows access to designated lots on the periphery of core campus work locations. Renewal is limited to current tan permit holders.

Thompson Permit: Allows access to Thompson Arena lot on South Park Street and is a free parking option. The Dartmouth/Downtown Hanover Shuttle, operated by Advance Transit, provides free shuttle service from Thompson Arena to campus and downtown. For route information, please see: www.advancetransit.com. Renewal is limited to current Thompson purple permit holders (30-days eligibility grace to renew after expiration). Individuals interested in upgrading to a Thompson purple permit should join the seniority based waitlist at Parking.Dartmouth.edu.

Dewey Permit: Allows access to Dewey lot north of the Medical School and is a free parking option. The Dartmouth/Downtown Hanover Shuttle, operated by Advance Transit, provides free shuttle service from the Dewey Lot to campus and downtown. For route information please see: www.advancetransit.com.

Lewiston Permit (new): Allows access to the Lewiston Lot in Norwich, VT, just over Ledyard Bridge. There are a limited number of permits offered on a first-come-first-served basis, priced at \$5/month. A free shuttle is available from Lewiston to Tuck Circle (search Lewiston shuttle from the Dartmouth homepage for a schedule and map). The shuttle will not run over summer term. If Lewiston permits have not sold-out, one will appear as a purchase option when logging into your account at Parking.Dartmouth.edu.

Opt-out Program: A flexible parking option that allows a user to park on campus for up to 4 days per month free of charge. This program assumes the user takes advantage of other commuting options during the remaining days of the month. Opt-out cannot be combined with other permit options. To Opt-out please contact Transportation Services.

Dartmouth Employee Carpool Discounts: Deeply discounted monthly parking rates when carpool participants are all Dartmouth employees. Contact Transportation Services for more information.

- Advance Transit, Stagecoach and The Current: Free bus service for employees and part of a broader effort to decrease traffic congestion in the region.
