Downloading Clips




Using the Firefox add-on "Easy YouTube Video Downloader," you can download video clips from YouTube for use in your digital media projects. Please note that all projects must be compliant with current Dartmouth policy and federal copyright rules, laws and regulations. For detailed information refer to http://www.dartmouth.edu/copyright/

1. From the Dock, open Mozilla Firefox



- 2. Go to www.youtube.com and navigate to the video of your choice.
- 3. Click on the "Download" menu below the video screen and select the file format and quality of your choice. For most uses, the best choice is "MP4" and the highest quality available, e.g. "1080p", "720p" higher numbers indicate greater resolution.
- 4. The file is automatically saved to the computer's "Downloads" folder.



- 5. To import the clip into iMovie for use in your video project
 - Open iMovie
 - From the iMovie menu, select "File>Import>Movies"
 - In the "Import" window, navigate to the movie clip in the "Downloads" folder.
 - From the "Save to" pull down menu, choose the hard disk where you want to save the imported files.
 - Select/create an event and click "Import."
