

The Dartmouth Cemetery

My interest in the Dartmouth Cemetery was first aroused when, as a Freshman in Dartmouth College, I wandered through the cemetery in 1898 - more than fifty years ago.

When, in March, 1948, I became a member of the Board of Selectmen, the supervision of the cemeteries was assigned to me.I was soon impressed by the fact that, when inquiries were made at the office regarding burials in the Partmouth Cemetery, the answer could be found only by roundabout methods, if indeed at all. Hence it seemed that a card index of all known burials in the cemetery would be of value.

In setting about the work, it seemed that, if the work was to be done effectively, all inscriptions should be read. It soon became evident that the charts of the cemetery - the one made in 1865; the other in 1911 - were antiquated since lots in appreciable numbers have been graded and occupied since the latter date.

As the reading of inscriptions on stones and monuments proceeded, it was found that many inscriptions could be read only with difficulty (especially was this true of the coarse granite stones which came into use following the iron-bearing slate); surface layers on some of the oldest slate slabs had long since split away carrying their inscriptions with them; stones which were noted in earlier records have disappeared. Therefore, it seemed that in years to come, a diagram of each lot, showing the relative position of monuments and stones and inscriptions which they bear, might be of value.

For the reasons mentioned above, the work has assumed greater proportions than was originally intended and fourc years have passed since it was begun. It is now completed to date. But "completion" is an erroneous term. Burials were made but never recorded and stones were never placed or, if they were, time, over a period of one hundred and eighty years, has wrought its changes and the stones have disappeared. It seems reasonable to assume that the burials in four lots in the cemetery will never be known. Also, here and there are unmarked graves whose occupants I have been unable to identify. Those who might have remembered and who could have contributed valuable information have, in turn, passed on.

A new chart of the cemetery has been completed. It was duplicated by Professor Fred F. Parker in February, 1950 and copies of it are on file in the office of the Selectmen.

The Dartmouth Cemetery Books 1 - 6

The 12-acre area of the Dartmouth Cemetery contains 410 lots. The books include diagrams of these lots together with inscriptions on stones and monuments. The purpose has been to reproduce inscriptions as they are. For this reason, errors though there may be, phonetic spelling and capitalization of the stone cutter, dates and age are as they appear on the stones.

Card Index. The card index which should accompany the books was compiled with a quite different aim in mind. Many monuments and stones bear only the date of death; some record age, others do not; some record only the year of birth and death. To such extent as possible, complete dates of birth, death and age have been brought together in the card index. For this work I have turned to sources noted below. Undoubtedly, more information could have been unearthed had time allowed.

- 2. Dartmouth Cemetery Association Book I. , is selections dock
- 3. Genalogy compiled by Gilman DuBois Frost.
- 4. Conversation and correspondence with families and relatives of deceased.
- 5. Vital statistics of Hanover and other towns.
- 6. William Worthington Dewey;"List of deths in the vicinity of Dartmouth College including likewise the Hamlet usually called Greensborough. From A. D., 1769 to the last date on the Register".
- 7. John Richards; "Records of Deaths, Interments and Inscriptions 1771 - 1858.
- 8. Asa Wright Fellows; "Cemetery Records".
- 9. Much valuable information has been contributed by Albert W. Conner, faithful servant of the Town for 45 years (1904 - 1949) as Sexton and by Percy E. Conner who worked with his father in the cemetery for many years and who took his father's place in 1949 when his father resigned.


- Jos Securi II Reduce - 193 Constant - 1990 - 199 As of this date, 1814 entries have been made in the card index. The number will be increased appreciably since many more interments are yet to be made in the cemetery.

Errors have been found in almost every source of reference. Stones are no exception. Dates and age found in the Town records do not always agree with those recorded on the stones nor do those recorded in Frost's Genealogy agree with those from other sources. Errors are to be found also in the Dartmouth Cemetery Association Book I.

By the same token, doubtless errors will be found in my work. For such errors, I alone am responsible and I can only hope that by due care in such matters as rereading all inscriptions and in attempting to reconcile differences in source material, some errors which might have appeared have been eliminated.

Dear Mr. Dickey;

May I call to your attention a matter that has been in my mind for some time.

During the summer of 1954, the College replaced the broken tablestone of Mary Brinsmead Wheelock in the Wheelock lot of the Dartmouth Cemetery.

When the tablestone and supporting stones were removed, a slate stone with inscriptions was found at the ground level. Also a companion stone was found under the tablestone of Eleazar Wheelock. The two stones were removed to the College storehouse.

Recently, I went to the storehouse to copy the inscriptions. The stones lie on the floor with the inscribed surfaces uppermost and are surrounded by all kinds of storage material. Stored on the stones were: a crated object so heavy that two men were needed to remove it; a 25 pound pail seemingly of roofing cement and a large, heavy metal fan.

In removing the objects, the men walked on the stones as freely as on the floor. A few days later, thinking that I had misread a date, I returned to find that the same objects had been placed back on the stones.

Already chips are broken away from the inscribed surfaces and, at two spots, the lettering is no longer readable. I predict that, in the end, their destination will be the junk pile.

While I have not as yet uncarthed sufficient evidence, I am of the belief that these are the stones placed by John Wheelock In 1810. In any case, these stones were placed as a memorial to Mary Brinsmead and Eleazar Wheelock and were never intended for display in museums or similar places.

It is my opinion as well as that of others with whom I have talked that the only place where these stones should be lodged is the place where they were found. It would seem that, if a recent history of these stones were to be written, it might be given the title of Rexpectable Vandalism.

Dear Mr. Chivers:

This will acknowledge your letter of November 30, 1955 to President Dickey in regard to the Wheelock stones.

I was very distressed to hear of the way these gravestones were being kept at the storehouse, and I immediately took steps to have the situation corrected. It was quite inexcusable the way they were being handledand it was contrary to the instructions I had given last spring at the time they were taken out of the ground.

Our purpose in taking them out was to see if the "ancient" tablestones could be preserved in a manner so that they could still be seen. We have obtained estimates on a new type of case which would have the modern tablestone, or perhaps the more recent one; on top exposed to the weather very much as at present. Then there would be a brass case on the side which would have the ancient stones under bulletproof glass which would enable them to be seen by anyone visiting the cemetery.

Apparently this was a very difficult fabrication job, and the total cost comes to around \$1,700. I would appreciate your reaction as to whether you think an expenditure of this size for this purpose is justified, or whether it would be better to follow your own suggestion, that the stones be put back where they were found. Would you be good enough to let me know what your opinion is on this subject?

Dear Mr. Meck;

It was with some hesitation that I wrote regarding the Wheelock stones and for two reasons: one that it might seem a trivial matter for those of you who carry weightier problems; the other that, having worked through a period of years on the cemetery records, I may be in danger of slipping over from sentiment to sentimentality, which I would be the first to avoid. You may be sure, therefore, that I deeply appreciated your cordial reply to my "memorandum" of November 30.

I have given much thought to the placement of the stones and, though it would be my hope that they might be returned to the cemetery, it would be most fortunate if they could be so placed that they could be seen.

Your suggestion that the stones be placed in a case is most interesting and would seem to solve the problem in the ideal way. If I understand correctly, one stone would remain as now, a tablestone and the other would be substituted for the supporting stone on one side.

It does seem that the cost is excessive but, after all, the project centers in the founding family of the College. I think those less familiar with the old burying ground would be surprised to learn of the number of people who visit it during the summer. And many of the visitors inquire for, or search out, the Wheelock lot.

I think the College was very generous in replacing the broken tablestone of Maria Wheelock during the past summer.

If I can be helpful in any way, please do not hesitate to let me know.
