The fire in Morton Hall has been extinguished and the state fire marshal is working to determine the cause of the fire. Thankfully, no one was injured. There is no ongoing threat to the community. We are grateful for the fast work of the Hanover Fire Department and Upper Valley first responders who helped to ensure that all students exited the building safely and to mitigate damage.

Administrators will meet with hall residents at noon today to offer more information and support. Affected students will be notified of the meeting location this morning.
